Failure to do so may result in permit suspension or revocation.</p> <p>13. This permit is issued for the period specified. It is subject to suspension or revocation, for management purposes or for cause, at the discretion of the State Director, upon written notice.</p>	<p>14. Permittee may request permit extension, in writing, at any time prior to expiration of the term of the permit, specifying a limited, definite amount of time required to complete the work.</p> <p>15. Permittee shall observe all Federal, State, and local laws and regulations applicable to the public lands and resources.</p> <p>16. Any correspondence about this permit or work conducted under its authority must cite the permit number. Any publication of results of work conducted under the authority of this permit must cite both the Bureau of Land Management and the permit number.</p> <p>17. Special conditions attached to this permit are made a part hereof.</p> <p>18. Permittee shall contact the affected Field Manager, prior to beginning any field work under the authority of this permit, by submitting a Fieldwork Authorization Request (Form 8151-3) or its equivalent, in person or by mail, except when a specific fieldwork authorization is included with the permit.</p>
