> 43 CFR 3833.1-2(d) states that a location notice for each mining claim, millsite, or tunnel site filed for recordation shall be accompanied by a service fee. As this is a mandatory requirement, there is no recordation unless the documents are accompanied by the stated fee, or until it is paid. Therefore, where a notice of location of a mining claim is submitted to BLM for recordation on Sept. 30, 1977, and the filing fee therefore is not paid to BLM until July 18, 1978, the recordation date of the notice of location is July 18, 1978. In the circumstances, the evidence of annual assessment work performed during the preceding assessment year or a notice of intention to hold the mining claim must be filed in the proper BLM office on or before Oct. 22, 1979, pursuant to 43 CFR 3833.2-1(a). Duly promulgated regulations have the force and effect of law and are binding on the Department.

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OPINION BY ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE FISHMAN

This appeal is from a decision dated July 19, 1979, of the Arizona State Office, Bureau of Land Management (BLM), declaring the Cholla Nos. 1 through 36 mining claims (AMC 13512 through AMC 13547) and the Ruth Nos. 1 though 34 mining claims (AMC 13548 through AMC 13581) abandoned and void for failure to timely file an affidavit of labor performed (annual assessment statement), as required by the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (FLPMA), 43 U.S.C. § 1744 (1976), and the regulation, 43 CFR 3833.2-1.

The facts are as follows: All of the above claims were located prior to October 21, 1976. The location notice for each of the above claims was received for recording by BLM on September 30, 1977. However, the location notices were not accompanied by the service fee, \$350 (\$5 per claim) as required by 43 CFR 3833.1-2(d). On December 4, 1978, BLM wrote to appellant advising that the service fee should have accompanied its filing and suggesting that appellant remit the required amount. No affidavits of assessment work or notices of intention to hold were submitted in the above mining claims on or before December 30, 1978. By letter dated June 18, 1979, BLM advised appellant that the service fee had to be remitted to BLM within 30 days of appellant's receipt of the letter or appellant's filings would be rejected. 1/ On July 18, 1979, appellant filed the required payment. On the following day, BLM issued the above decision holding appellant's claims abandoned and void for failure to comply with 43 CFR 3833.2-1(a). 2/

In his statement of reasons appellant points out that the relevant regulation is 43 CFR 3833.1-2(d) which provides: "(d) Each claim or site filed shall be accompanied by a one time \$5 service fee which is not returnable. A notice or certificate of location shall

1/ The letter also requested appellant to furnish maps or sketches showing the location of each claim as required by 43 CFR 3833.1-2(c)(7).

2/ 43 CFR 3833.2-1(a) (May 1979) states:

"The owner of an unpatented mining claim located on Federal lands on or before October 21, 1976, shall file in the proper BLM office on or before October 22, 1979, or on or before December 30 of each calendar year following the calendar year of such recording, which ever date is sooner, evidence of annual assessment work performed during the preceding assessment year or a notice of intention to hold the mining claim."

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not be accepted if it is not accompanied by the service fee and shall be returned to the owner." Appellant notes that the language "shall be accompanied by" in the regulation is mandatory. Appellant interprets the regulation as requiring the rejection of all filings not accompanied by the service fee, and asserts that his filings should accordingly have been rejected.

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Appellant asks the Board to remand the case with instructions to find either that the initial filings of the location notices was ineffective, or, in the alternative, that recordation was effective on July 18, 1979, when the service fee was filed.

[1] The regulation dispositive of this appeal is 43 CFR 3833.1-2(d), <u>supra</u>. Both sentences of that regulation refer to the requirement that the service fee must accompany the claim or site filed, and the second sentence mandates rejection and return to its owner, of a filing not accompanied by the fee.

In a recent decision, Joe B. Cashman, 43 IBLA 239 (1979), we construed that regulation in a manner which controls the disposition of the case at bar. We stated at 43 IBLA 240:

43 CFR 3833.1-2 requires that, for mining claims, millsites, or tunnel sites located prior to October 21, 1976, a copy of the location notice must be recorded with the proper office of BLM within 3 years, or before October 22, 1979. For such claims or sites located after October 21, 1976, the location notice must be recorded in the proper BLM office within 90 days following date of location. 43 CFR 3833.1-2(d) states that each claim or site filed with BLM shall be accompanied by a \$5 service fee. This is a mandatory requirement. Without payment of the filing fee, there is no recordation. Thus, as the filing fee for the notices of Apex No. 1 and Apex No. 2 millsites was not paid until February 10, 1978, it must be held that the date of recordation of these claims with BLM cannot be considered to have occurred earlier than that date. [Emphasis in original.]

It necessarily follows that the recordation date in the case at bar is July 18, 1978, the date the filing fees were paid. In the circumstances, under 43 CFR 3833.2-1(a) evidence of assessment work performed during the preceding assessment year or a notice of intention to hold the claims was not required to be filed in the proper BLM office until October 22, 1979.

Therefore, the decision of July 19, 1979 holding the mining claims void for failure to file such instruments prior to December 31, 1978, was in error.

IBLA 79-532 79-540

Accordingly, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Land Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, the decision appealed from is reversed and the case remanded to the Arizona State Office for further action in conformance with the views expressed herein.





Such authority would be required if the filing of 5 the service fee were to relate back to the original recordation 6 of the location notices.

The penalty stated in § 3833.4 of the regulations promul-8 gated on January 27, 1977 is that:

> "The failure to file such instruments as are required by Sections 3833.1 and 3833.2 within the time periods prescribed therein shall be deemed conclusively to constitute an abandonment of the mining claim, mill site or tunnel site and it shall be void."

13 The time period for paying the service fee was simultaneous ("accompanied by") with filing the location notices for recording. 14 Therefore, because each location notice filed was not "accompanied 15 by a \$5.00 service fee" on September 30, 1977, the filing of the 16 location notices should have been rejected and this date cannot 17 18 be considered as the date of filing. In a similar situation, the Board has held that, because the regulations provide no authority 19 20 for filing maps later than 90 days after the date of location, 21 such maps cannot be received subsequent to that time and relate back to the date of filing of the location notices. 22 Roy M. Byram, 23 39 IBLA 32 (1979). Applying another regulation (43 C.F.R. 24 § 3103.3-1) requiring an oil and gas lease offer "shall be accompanied" by the first year's rental and filing fee, the Board 25 26 found that the offer must be rejected if not accompanied by the 27 payment. Charles F. Mullins, 6 IBLA 184 (1972).

28 Nowhere do the regulations state that the late filing 29 of the service fee will relate back to the initial incomplete 30 filing of the location notices giving rise to the requirement 31 to file assessment work affidavits based upon the initial filing 32 date. The Board has held in numerous cases that regulations

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must be so clear that there is no basis for a party's noncom-1 2 pliance with those regulations before they may be interpreted so as to deprive the party of a statutory right. William S. 3 4 Kilroy, et al., 70 I.D. 520 (1963); Murphy Oil Corporation, 5 13 IBLA 160 (1973); Wallace S. Bingham, 82 ID 377 (1975).

In addition to the regulations not stating that the effective date of filing a late service fee will be on the date of the original location notice filing, the State Office made statements to appellant affirmatively leading appellant to believe that a subsequent filing of the service fee would avoid 11 any jeopardization of its claims. In the State Office letter 12 dated December 4, 1978 to appellant, it was stated that the regulations "require that each claim or site filed shall be accompanied by a \$5.00 service fee". Then the letter invites appellant to submit the fee without advising the appellant that, unless assessment work affidavits or a notice of intent to hold were filed by December 31, 1978 the claims would be held void.

18 The State Office in its June 18, 1979 letter to 19 appellant stated that appellant would have 30 days from the 20 date of the letter to submit the service fee. This letter went 21 further to state that failing to submit such fee would cause a 22 decision to be issued rejecting the filing and stating the only 23 penalty would be the necessity to refile under the requirements 24 of 43 C.F.R. § 3833.1-2. Again, there was no mention of an 25 interpretation which would be made by the State Office that if 26 appellant submitted the service fee as requested, without having 27 filed assessment work affidavits or notices of intent to hold 28 when it was already too late to do so, it would cause the claims 29 to be held void. To the contrary, if the service fee had not 30 been filed as requested by the State Office, the initial filing 31 would have been rejected, there would have been no requirement 32 imposed by the State Office to file the assessment work affidavits

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prior to December 31, 1978 and the claims would not have been 2 held void.

3 When the State Office requested, in its June 18, 1979 4 letter, the \$350.00 filing fee be paid, that office had the 5 facts at hand to know that, if the fee were paid as requested, 6 the State Office would hold the claims to be void, causing the 7 appellant to lose the filing fee, and requiring the relocation 8 of the claims and payment of another filing fee. On the other 9 hand, if the appellant had not followed the State Office's in-10 structions, the original filing of the location notices would 11 merely have been rejected, and appellant could then have recorded 12 the location notices accompanied by the filing fee. We do not 13 contend that there was any intention of the State Office to 14 trap appellant into having its claims voided and having to pay 15 a double service fee. However, the result produced by the 16 actions of the State Office could not have been more effective 17 than if such were the intention. Therefore, as a matter of 18 equity and fair administration, as well as a matter of proper 19 interpretation of the regulations, we submit that the State 20 Office should have rejected the intial filing of the location 21 notices. This would have allowed appellant to refile the 22 location notices accompanied by the service fee and assessment 23 work affidavits at any time before October 22, 1979.

24 In the alternative, the State Office should have 25 found that the recordings of the Cholla and Ruth mining claims 26 were effective on the date on which the last requirement of 43 27 C.F.R. § 3833.1-2 was fulfilled, i.e. on July 18, 1979 when the 28 service fee was paid. The requirement that the service fee 29 accompany the filing of the location notices is expressed in 30 the mandatory terms, "shall be accompanied". Where the Depart-31 ment of the Interior has had occasion to apply mandatory filing 32 requirements to determine priorities between mineral lease

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offerors, it has consistently held that the effective date of 1 2 a filing which does comply with a mandatory requirement of the 3 regulations is the date on which the last mandatory requirement 4 W. H. Burnett, 64 I.D. 230, 231 (1957); Celia R. is met. 5 Kammerman, et al., 66 I.D. 255, 263 (1959); Ruby Company, 6 72 I.D. 189, 192 (1965). Therefore, because no priorities of 7 other parties or expiration of deadlines for the recordings 8 have intervened, the late filing of the service fee should be 9 considered as a curable defect which was cured, and the record-10 ing requirement completed, on July 18, 1979 when the service 11 fee was paid.

CONCLUSION

13 We request respectfully that the Board hold that the 14 Cholla and Ruth mining claims have not been abandoned or voided 15 by failure to file an assessment work affidavit prior to 16 December 31, 1978 and to remand this matter to the State Office 17 with instructions to find either that the initial filings of 18 the location notices were ineffective for the appellant having 19 failed to remit the service fee or, in the alternative, that 20 the completion of the recordation of the claims was effective as 21 of the date (July 18, 1979) on which the last requirement of 22 § 3833.1-2 (the filing of the service fee) was completed.
