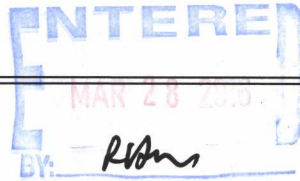

SPECIAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

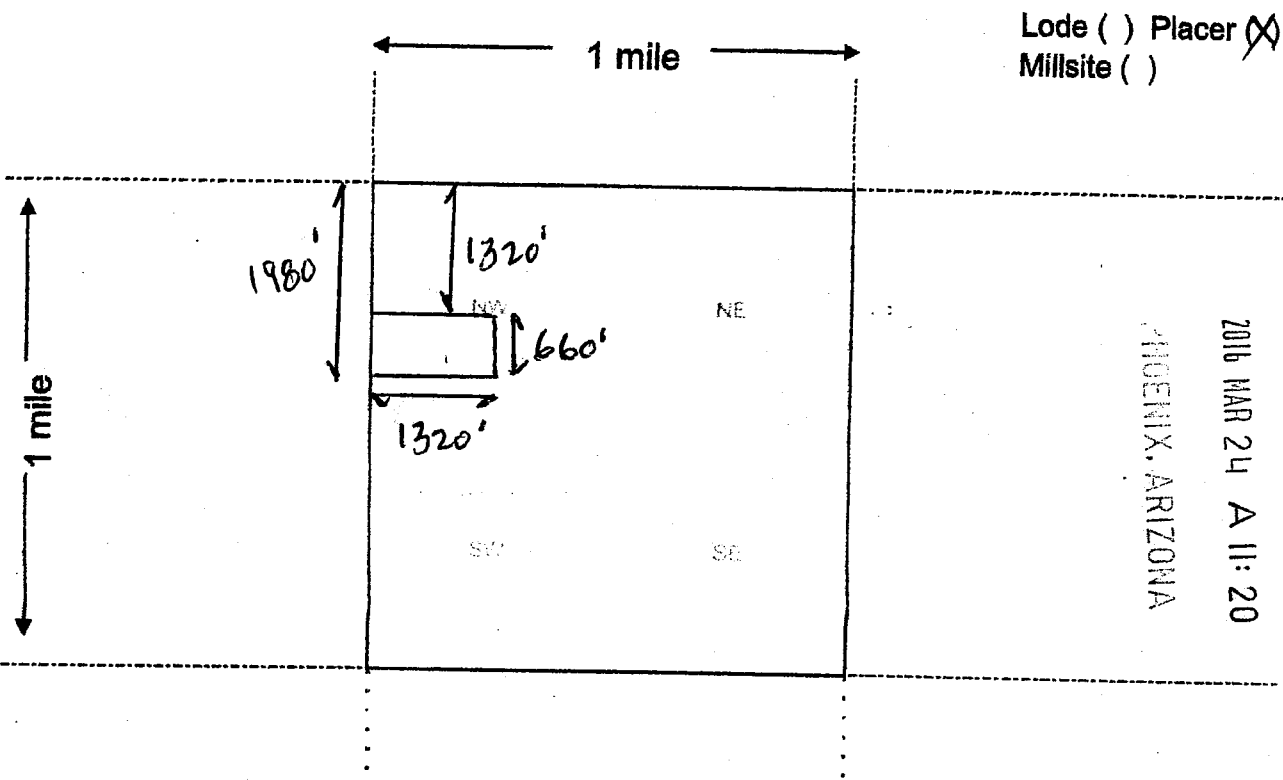

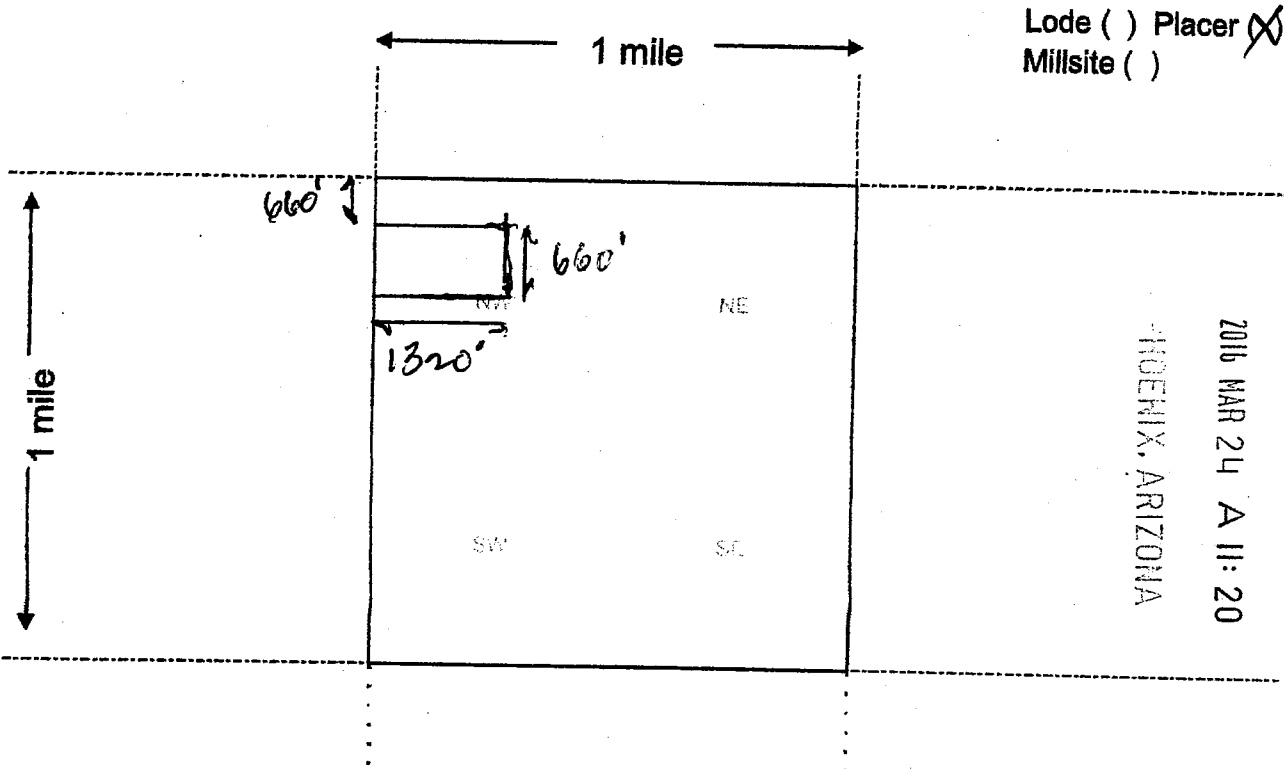

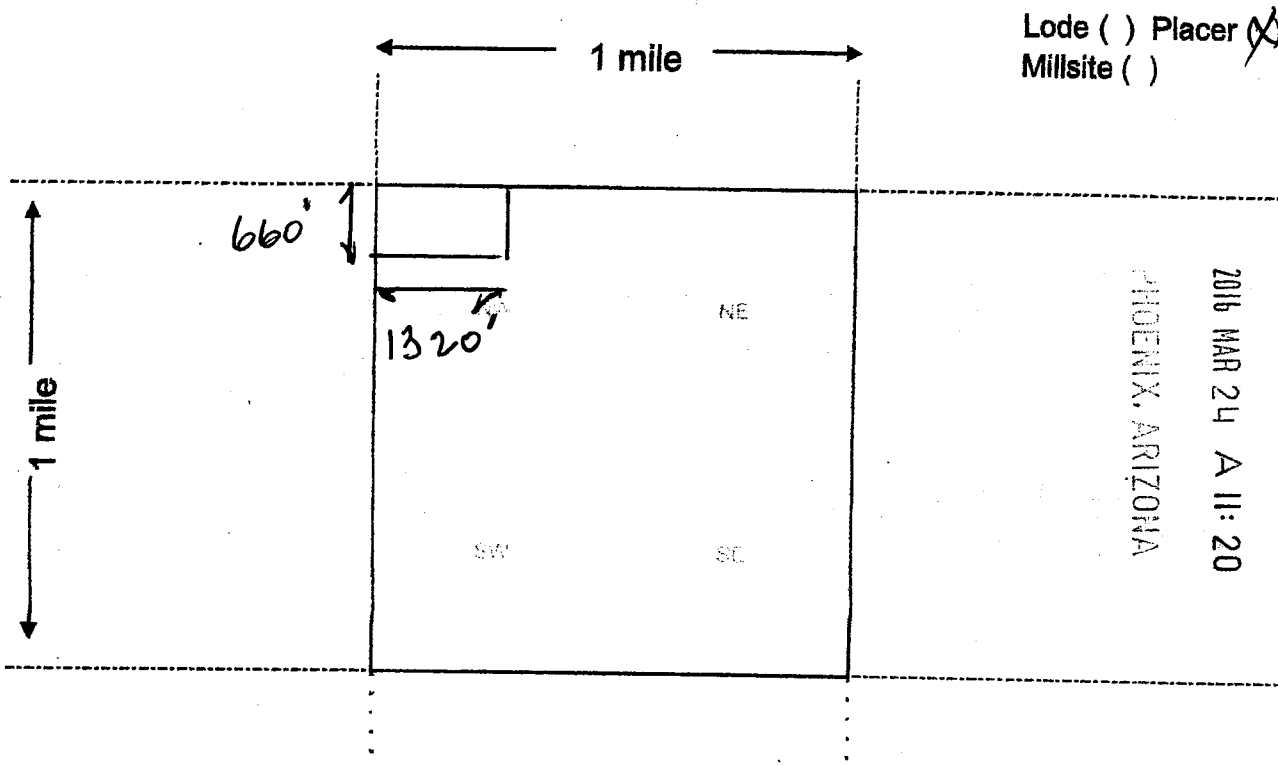

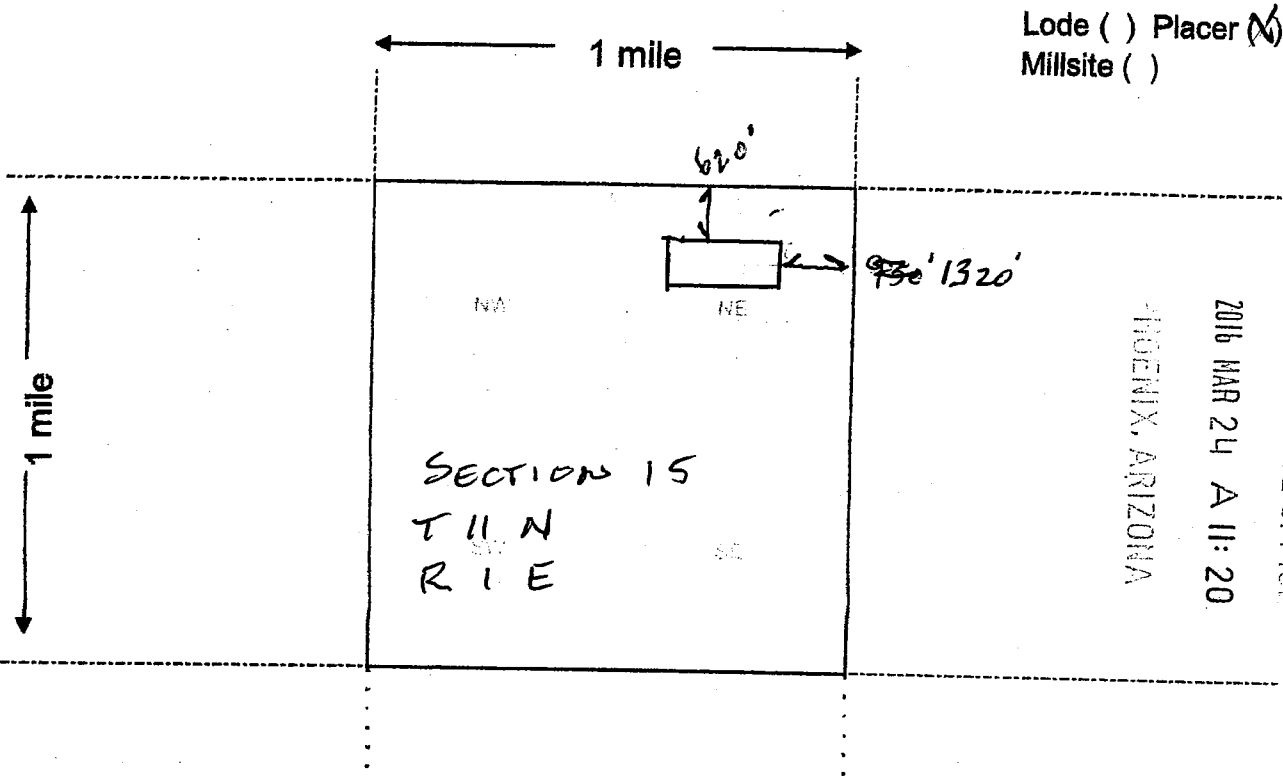

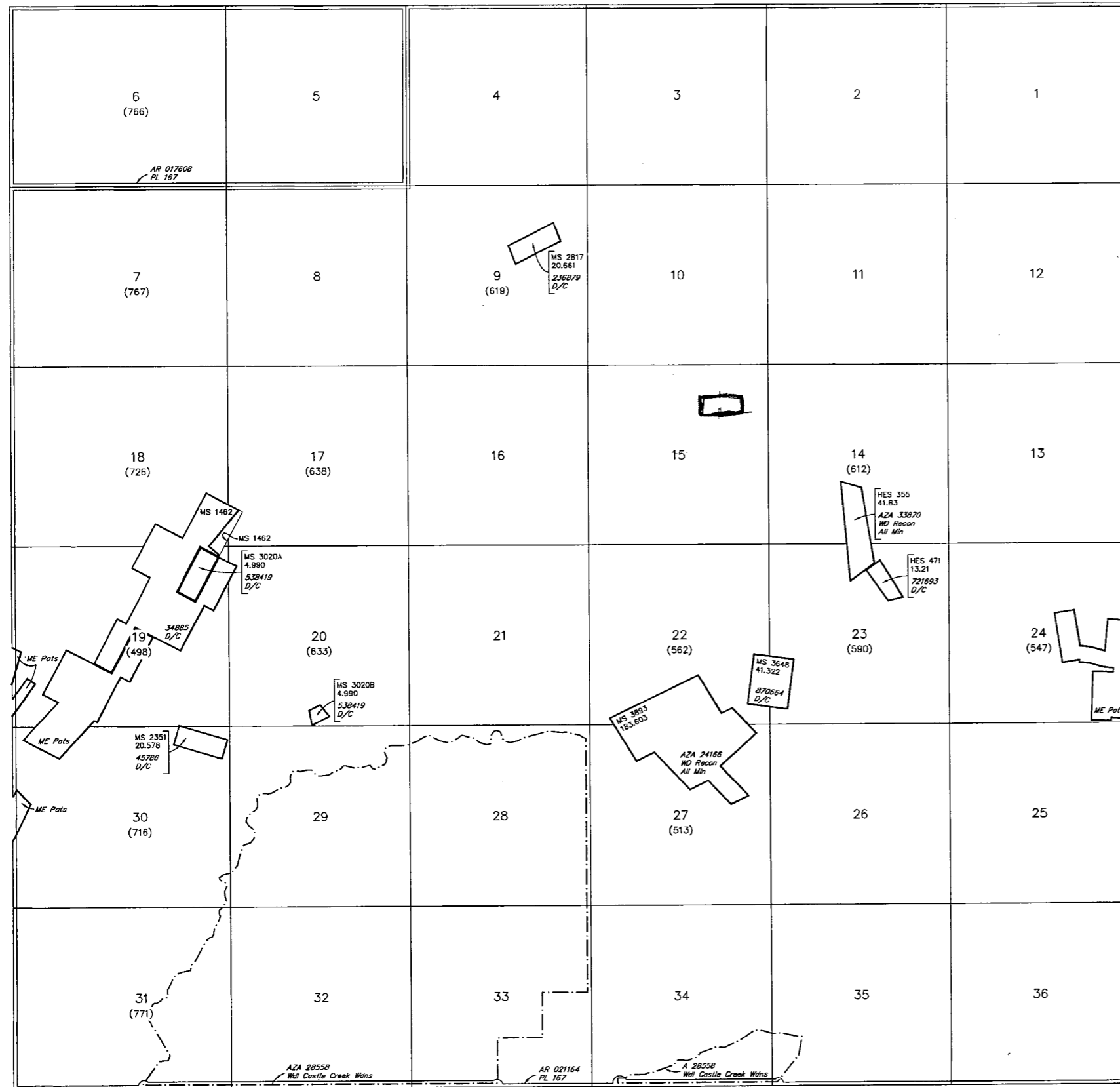
