ARIZONA

ABOLISHING THE CROOK NATIONAL FOREST AND TRANSFERRING ITS LANDS TO THE TONTO, CORONADO AND GILA NATIONAL

By virtue of the authority vested in the President by the act of June 4, 1897

(30 Stat. 11, 36; 16 U.S. C. 473), and pursuant to Executive Order No. 10355 of May 26, 1952 (17 F R. 4831), and upon the recommendation of the Department of Agriculture, it is ordered as follows:

The Crook National Forest in Arizona as defined by Presidential Proclamation of July 1, 1908, and as subsequently modifled, is hereby abolished.
