Maintenance Fee Waiver Certifications Denied Mining Claims Declared Forfeited

The Maintenance Fee Waiver Certifications (small miner waivers) filed for the 2021 assessment year, for the mining claims listed above, are denied. Because the small miner waivers are denied and because the required maintenance fee payments due on or before September 1, 2020, were not paid, these claims are declared forfeited.

The Bureau of Land Management's (BLM) regulations at 43 CFR 3830.21, and 3834.11(a)(2) state that by September 1 of each year, holders of mining claims must pay an annual maintenance fee of \$165 per claim per 20 acres or portion thereof. In lieu of paying the required maintenance fee, claimants may submit a valid small miner waiver, in accordance with 43 CFR 3835.1, 3835.10, and 3835.11.

In accordance with 43 CFR 3835.1(b), to qualify for a small miner waiver, you and all related parties must hold no more than a total of 10 mining claims or sites nationwide. As defined at

43 CFR 3830.5, "related party means: a) the spouse and dependent children of the claimant as defined in section 152 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 [26 U.S.C. section 152]; or, b) A person who controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with the claimant." "Control means actual control, legal control, or the power to exercise control, through or by common directors, officers, stockholders, a voting trust, or a holding company or Investment Company, or any other means."

Small miner waivers were filed for the seventeen mining claims listed above. The BLM has reviewed the case files for each of the mining claims listed above to verify that the owners qualify for a small miner waiver. The BLM has made the following findings:

1. Arizona Corporate Commission documents show that Big Bug Mining District LLC is a corporation registered in Arizona, dating back to 2017. According to Arizona Corporate Commission documents, the current statutory agent is Timothy Hayden. Listed as the current managing members are Dale C. Bennett, Owen Wildman, Gerald A. Baker, and Philip L. Condrey.
2. Big Bug Mining District LLC owns 10 mining claims in Arizona. The 2021 maintenance fees were paid on these claims. The claim numbers are AMC437424, AMC439458, AMC440507, AMC443155, AMC445640, AMC452459, AMC452460, AMC452461, AMC457154, AMC457155.
3. The current mailing address BLM has for Big Bug Mining District LLC is PO Box 1238, Mayer, AZ 86333-1238. This is the same address on file for Owen Wildman.
4. Ownership of the mining claims is shown on an enclosure.

In accordance with 43 C.F.R. 3835.92(d), because you or a co-claimant own more than 10 mining claims or sites and submitted a small miner waiver request and failed to pay the required maintenance fee on or before the due date for the 2021 assessment year, the mining claims listed above are declared forfeited and void as of September 1, 2020. Additionally you and the co-claimants may be subject to criminal penalties under 18 U.S.C. 1001.

Reclamation Requirements

This decision does not relieve you of the liability for reclamation of all areas disturbed by your activities on lands covered by the subject mining claim(s) and/or site(s). After you complete the reclamation, you must notify the authorized officer of the appropriate surface managing agency so that the authorized officer may conduct a final site inspection and determine whether you may be released from liability. If you fail to reclaim the land to the satisfaction of the authorized officer, the surface management agency may cite you for noncompliance under its surface management regulations.

For land administered by the BLM, if you fail to reclaim the land to the satisfaction of the authorized officer as required in 43 CFR Subpart 3809, the BLM will issue an order of noncompliance under 43 CFR 3809.601(a). If you fail to comply with the noncompliance

order, the BLM may take further action under 43 CFR 3809.604. Failure to conduct reclamation is a prohibited act that may subject you to criminal penalties. (See 43 CFR 3809.605(h) and 43 CFR 3809.700)

Appeal Procedures

This decision may be appealed to the Interior Board of Land Appeals (IBLA), Office of the Secretary, in accordance with the regulations contained in 43 CFR Part 4, and the enclosed Form 1842-1. If an appeal is taken, your notice of appeal must be filed in this office (at the above address) within 30 days from receipt of this decision. The appellant has the burden of showing that the decision appealed from is in error.



If you request a stay, you have the burden of proof to demonstrate that a stay should be granted.

Standards for Obtaining a Stay

Except as otherwise provided by law or other pertinent regulation, a petition for a stay of a decision pending appeal shall show sufficient justification based on the following standards:

- (1) The relative harm to the parties if the stay is granted or denied,
- (2) The likelihood of the appellant's success on the merits,
- (3) The likelihood of immediate and irreparable harm if the stay is not granted, and
- (4) Whether the public interest favors granting the stay.

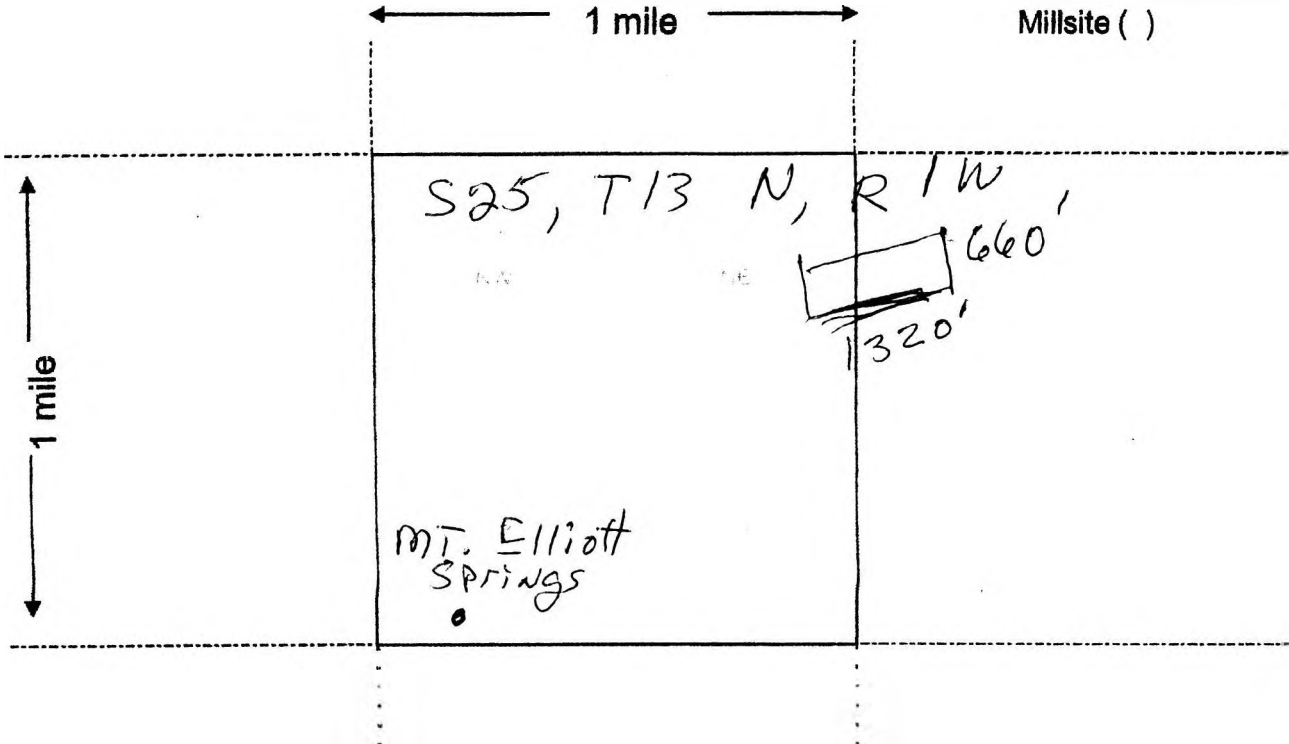

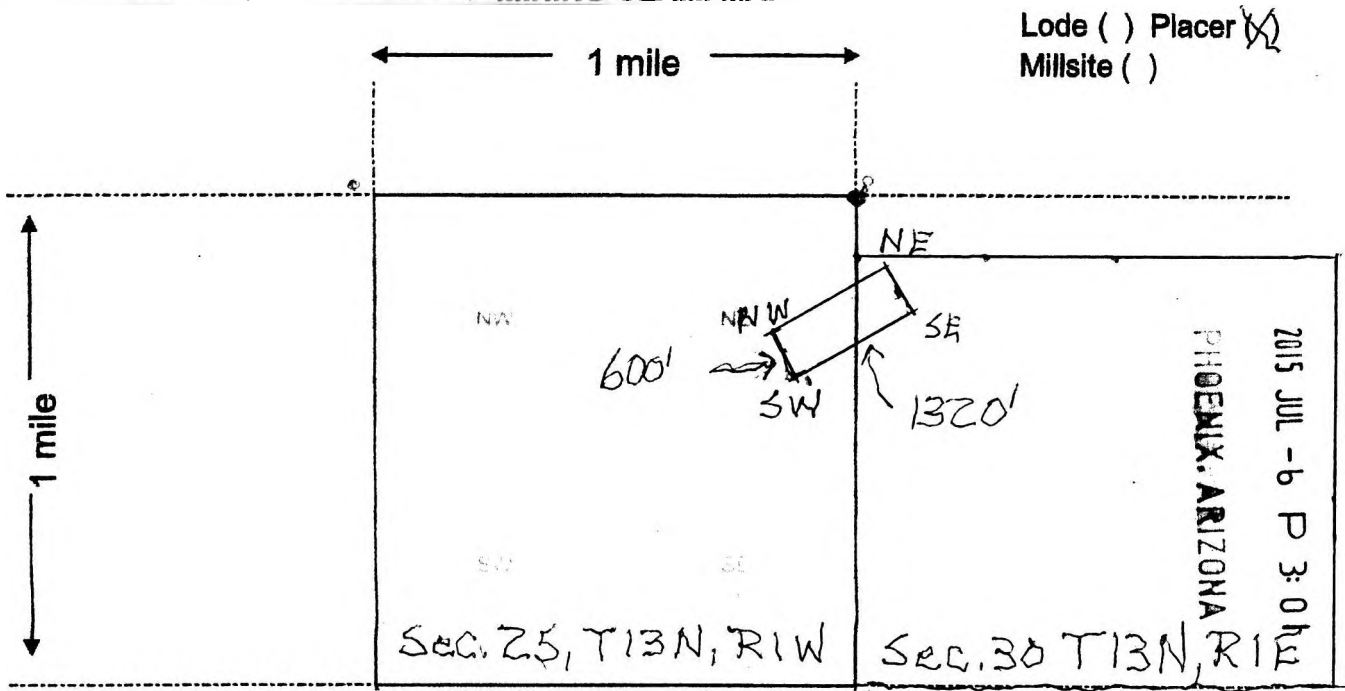

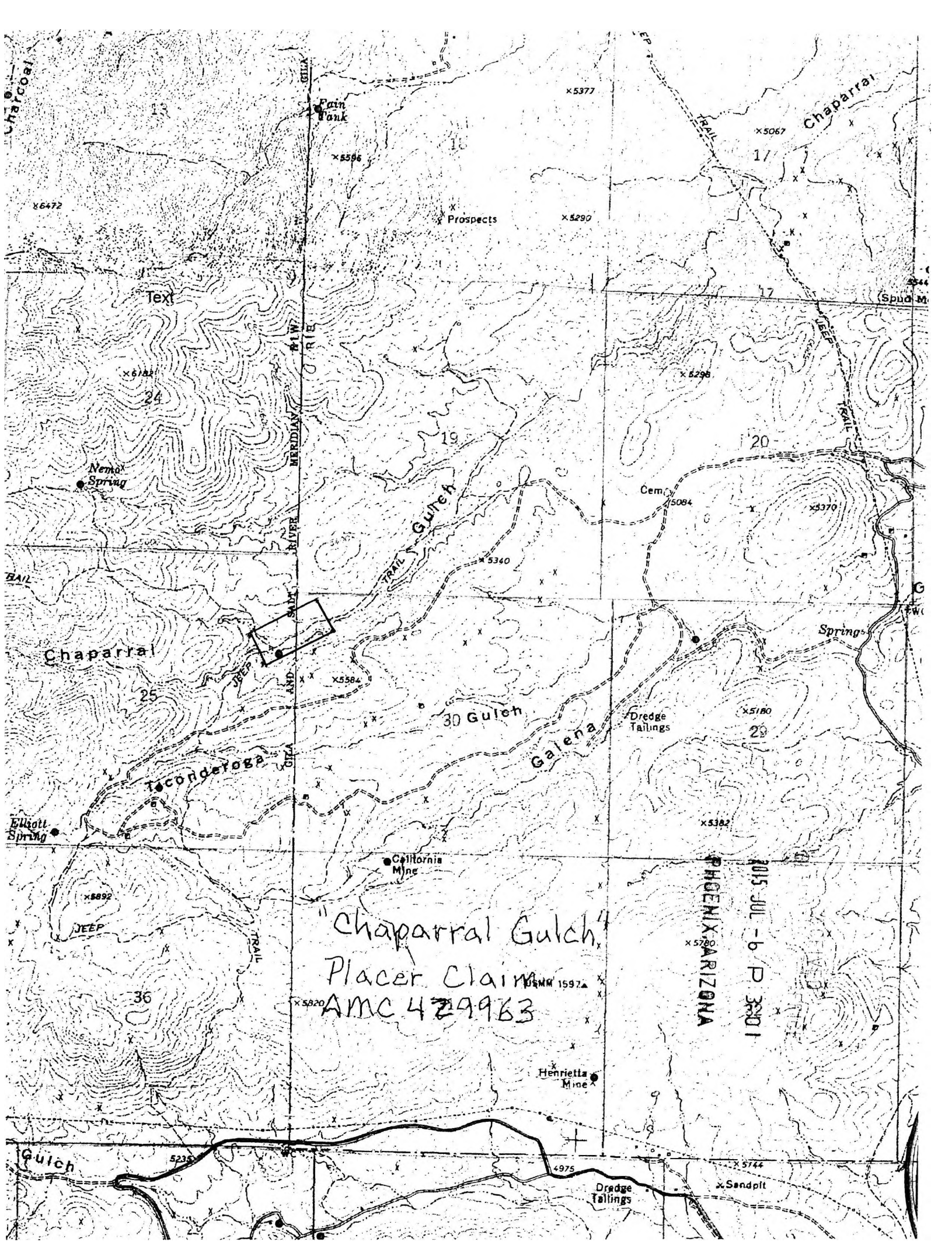

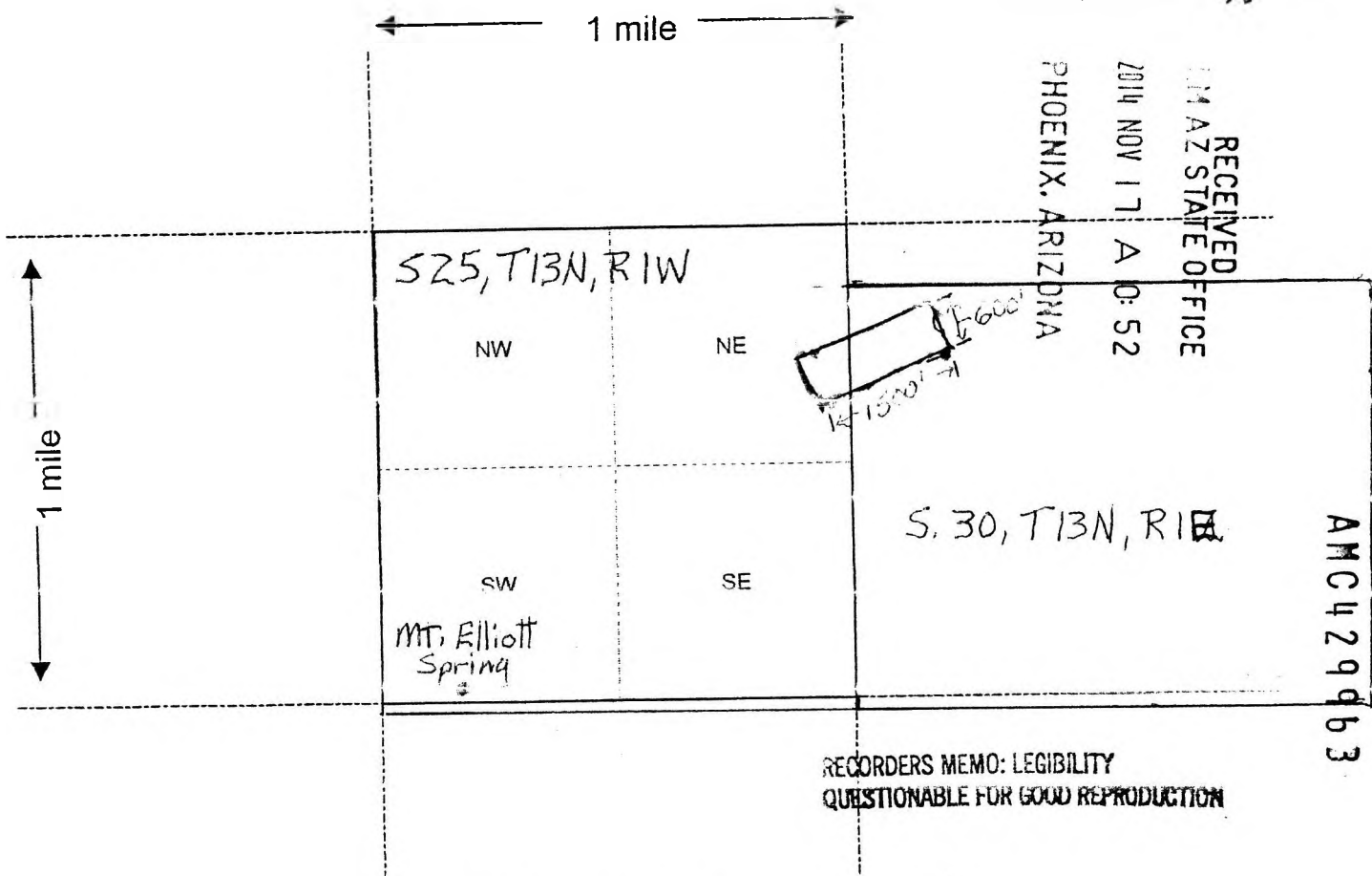

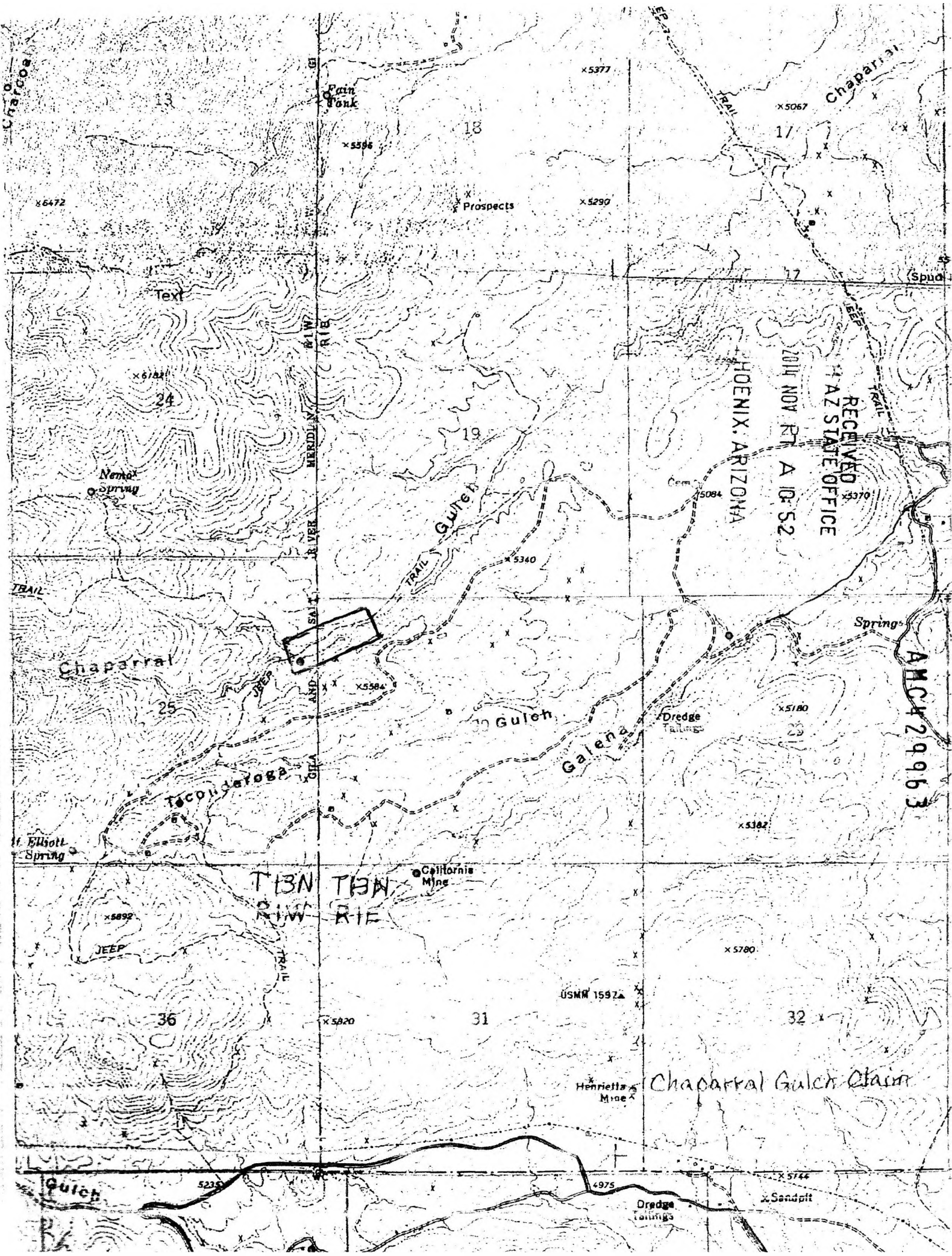
