

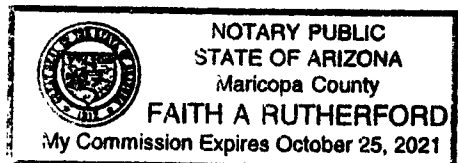

ORDER PROVIDING FOR THE OPENING OF PUBLIC LANDS  
TO MINERAL LOCATION, ENTRY, AND PATENT

Under the authority of the Act of April 25, 1932 (47 Stat. 136; 43 U.S.C. 154) and the regulations thereunder contained in 43 C.F.R. 189.36, and pursuant to section 2.22 (a) of Departmental Order No. 2563 of August 16, 1950, of the Secretary of the Interior, it is ordered as follows:

Subject to valid existing rights and the provisions of existing withdrawals, the following described lands shall, commencing at 10:00 a.m., on the thirty-fifth day after the date of this Order, be open to location, entry, and patenting under the United States Mining Law, subject to the stipulations quoted below, to be executed and acknowledged in favor of the United States by the locators, for themselves, their heirs, successors, and assigns, and recorded in the county records and in the United States Land & Survey Office at Phoenix, Arizona, before any rights attach thereto:

There is reserved to the United States, its agents and employees, at all times, free ingress to, passage over, and egress from all of the above described lands for the purpose of inspection; there is further reserved to the United States, its successors and assigns the prior right to use any of the lands hereinabove described, to construct, operate, and maintain canals, dikes, waterways, ditches, dams, reservoirs, telephone and telegraph lines, electric transmission lines, roadways and appurtenant works, including the right to take and remove from the lands hereinabove described such construction materials as may be required in the construction of irrigation works, without any payment made by the United States, or its successor for such rights.

The locator further agrees that the United States, its officers, agents, and employees and its successors or assigns, shall



not be held liable for any damage to the improvements or workings of the lcaater resulting from the construction, operation and maintenance of any works of the United States and/or the removal of construction materials from the lands hereinabove described.

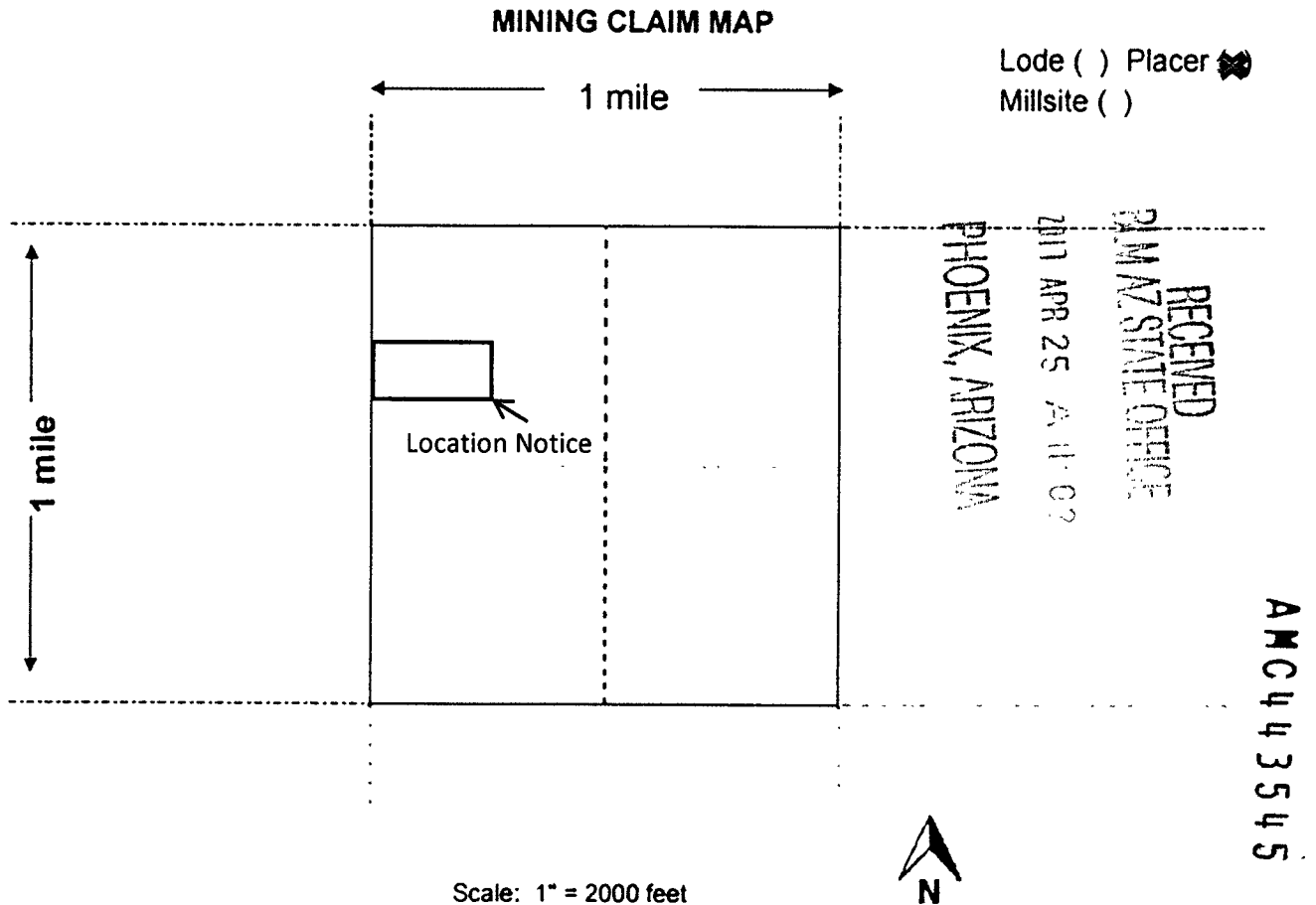
