Thank you for your letter dated January 8, 2018, discussing mining claim AMC 445995 and describing your communications with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), including your correspondence to the State Director of BLM's Arizona State Office and your discussion with BLM's Phoenix Office. In your January 8, 2018, letter, you did not identify a decision issued by BLM.

The Board has no general supervisory authority over BLM.¹ The Board's appellate review authority cannot be invoked simply because someone may object to something BLM is doing, but instead there must be an identifiable decision.² You have not identified a "decision" issued by BLM, and so the Board is unable to docket an appeal.

Therefore, the Board lacks jurisdiction regarding the matters you raised in your January 8, 2018, letter.

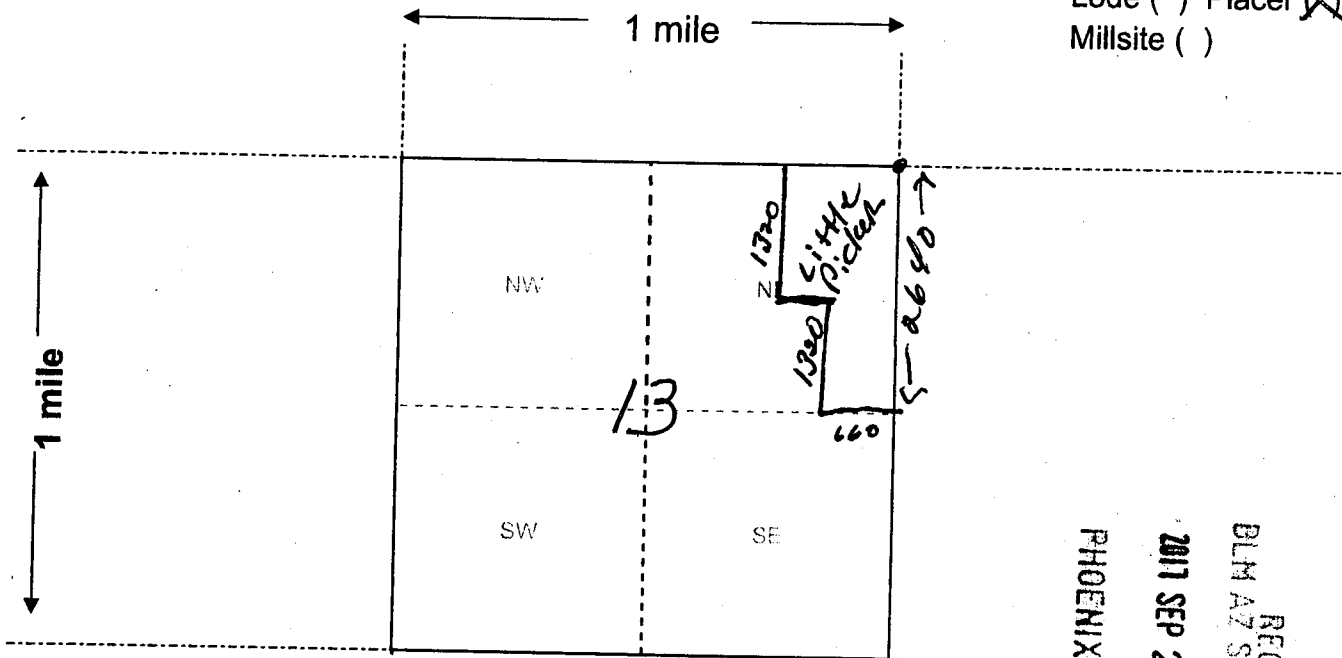
