- (4) Whether the public interest favors granting the stay.

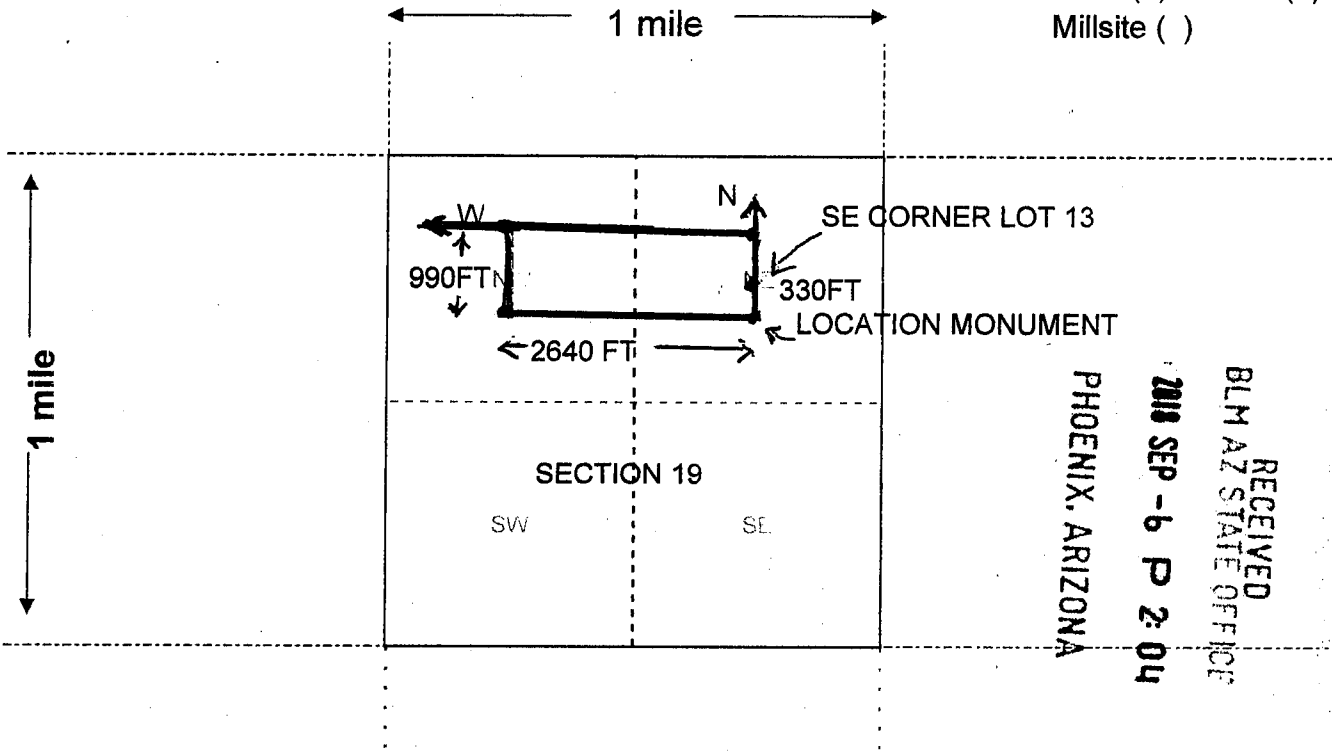
