In accordance with the instructions received from the Office of the Surveyor General, A. G., in circular letter of December 1st. 1880, - I, on the 29th of January 1881, took the Western Elongation of the North Star, by which I made the variation

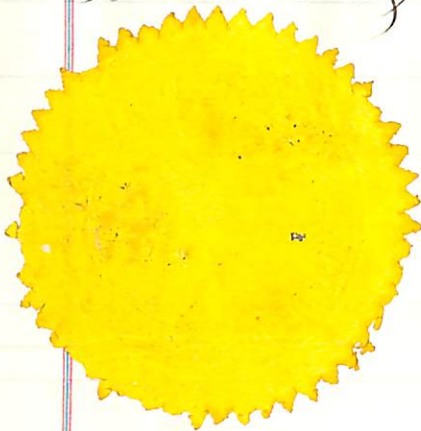

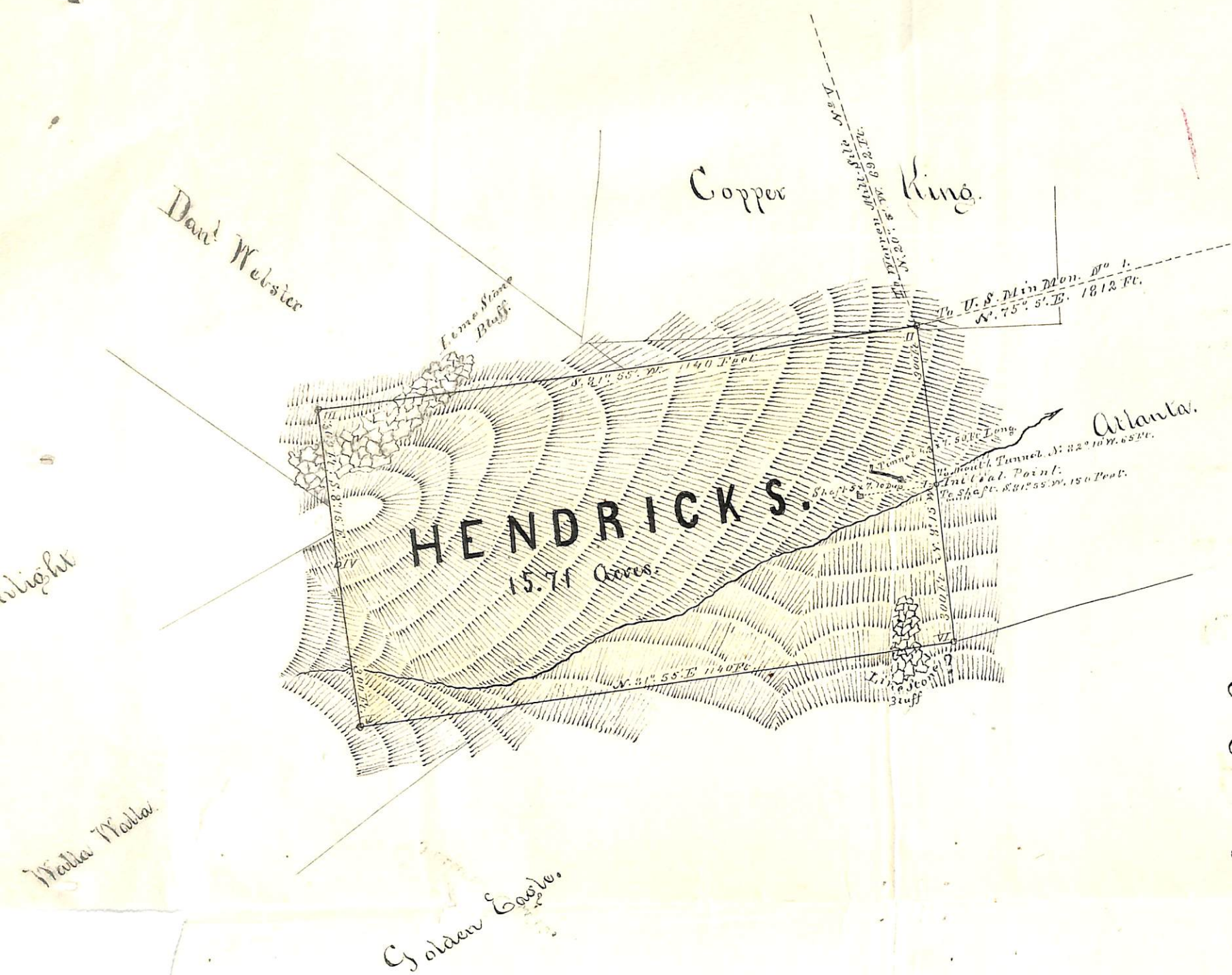
