By comparison with the U.S. Standard Meridian established for Tombstone Mining District I find the variation of my Transit to be 11° 25' East.

I commence at the Initial monument described in the notice of location situated upon the North East end line of the Owls Nest Mining Claim Lot No. 97. where I set Post 5 ft long 4 ins sq 1 ft in ground and build around it a monument of stone and earth 2 1/2 ft high. marked I.M. 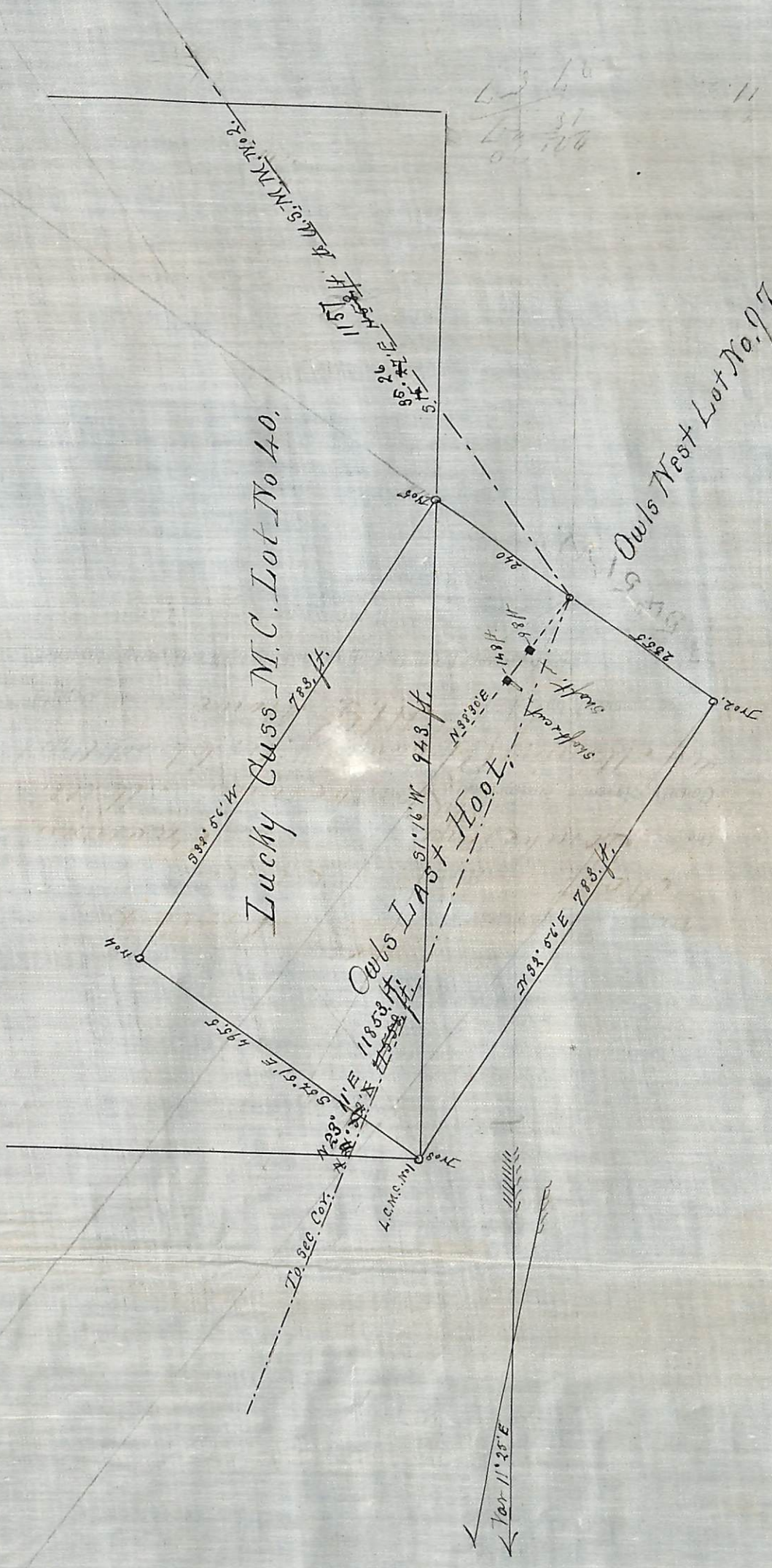
