By comparison with the United States Standard Meridian established for Tombstone Mining District, I find the variation of my instrument to be  
 $11^{\circ} 25'$  East.

I commence at the Initial Monument of the claim, as described in the Notice of Location:— a monument of stones on the center of the ledge and north of the Discovery Shaft; from which U.S. M. M. No 6 bears  
 $S. 45^{\circ} 17' E.$

U.S. M. M. No 2 bears  $S. 69^{\circ} 43' E.$  5835 ft. dist. and cor. to Secs. 1, 2, 35 & 36, on North boundary Tp. 20 S. R. 22 E. bears  
 $N. 45^{\circ} 16' E.$  13 275. ft. distant.

I run a preliminary line through center of claim, and find the bearing to be  $N. 27^{\circ} 0' E.$  and  $S. 27^{\circ} 0' W.$   
I measure along the center line of claim,  $S. 27^{\circ} 0' W.$

Variation  $11^{\circ} 25'$  East  
and find the South Center End Monument to be distant from the Initial Monument

while the Location Notice calls for 750 ft. — I, therefore, set at 750 ft. a post 5 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 1 ft. in the ground, in a monument of stone, marking the South Center End of claim.

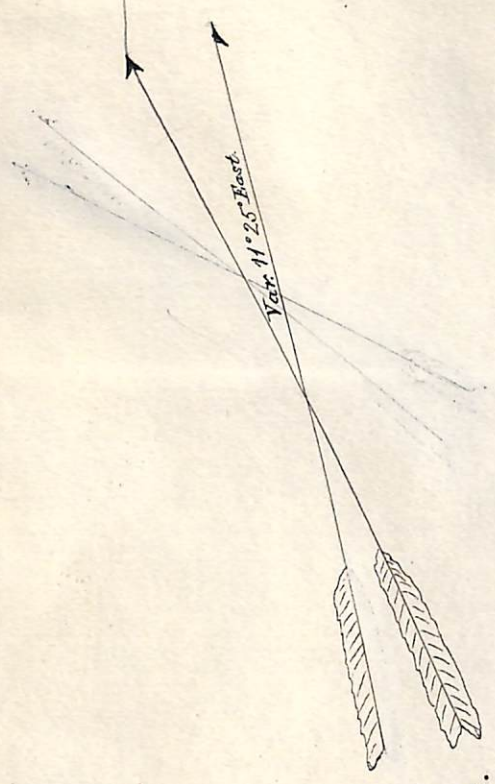

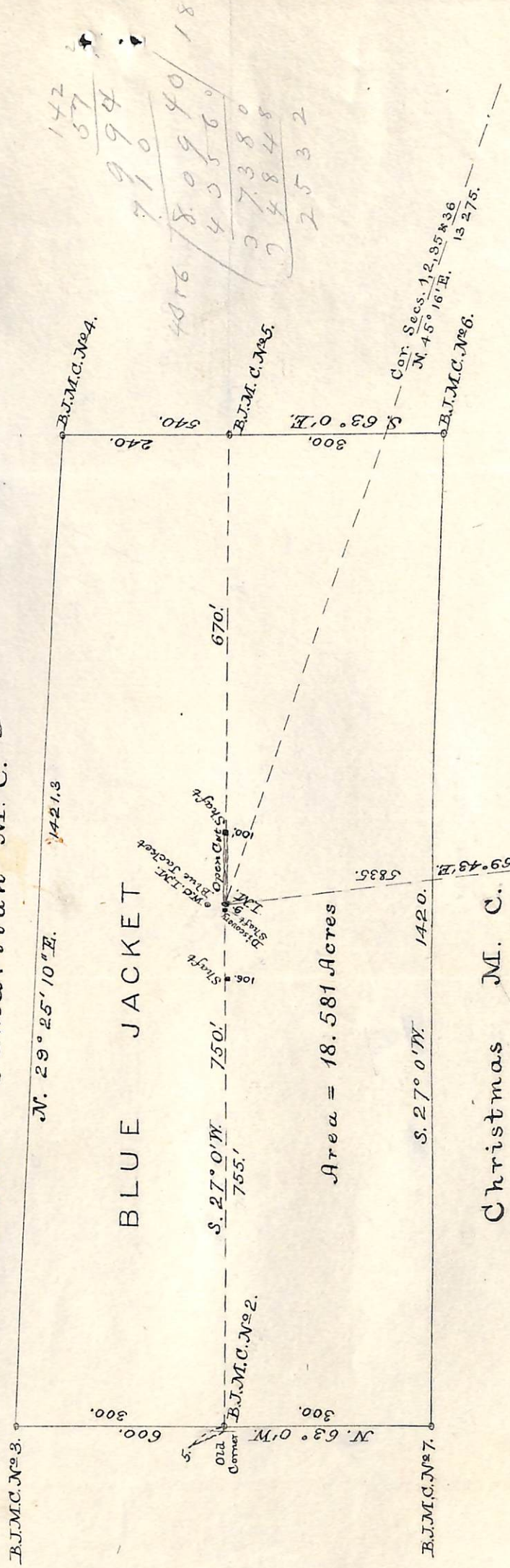
