Rusch & Zellweger, owners of said Mill Site hereby amend the notice of location of said Mill Site to better define said claim and the locus thereof so that the same shall read as follows:

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, in compliance with the requirements of chapter six, title thirty two of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the local customs, laws and regulations have located, taken up and claimed five acres of this ground as a Mill Site for milling and reducing ores, and situated in the Owl Head Mining District, Pinal County, Arizona, about 15 miles North from the Steam Pump Ranch on lower Canon de Oro, commencing at a monument of stones at the S. 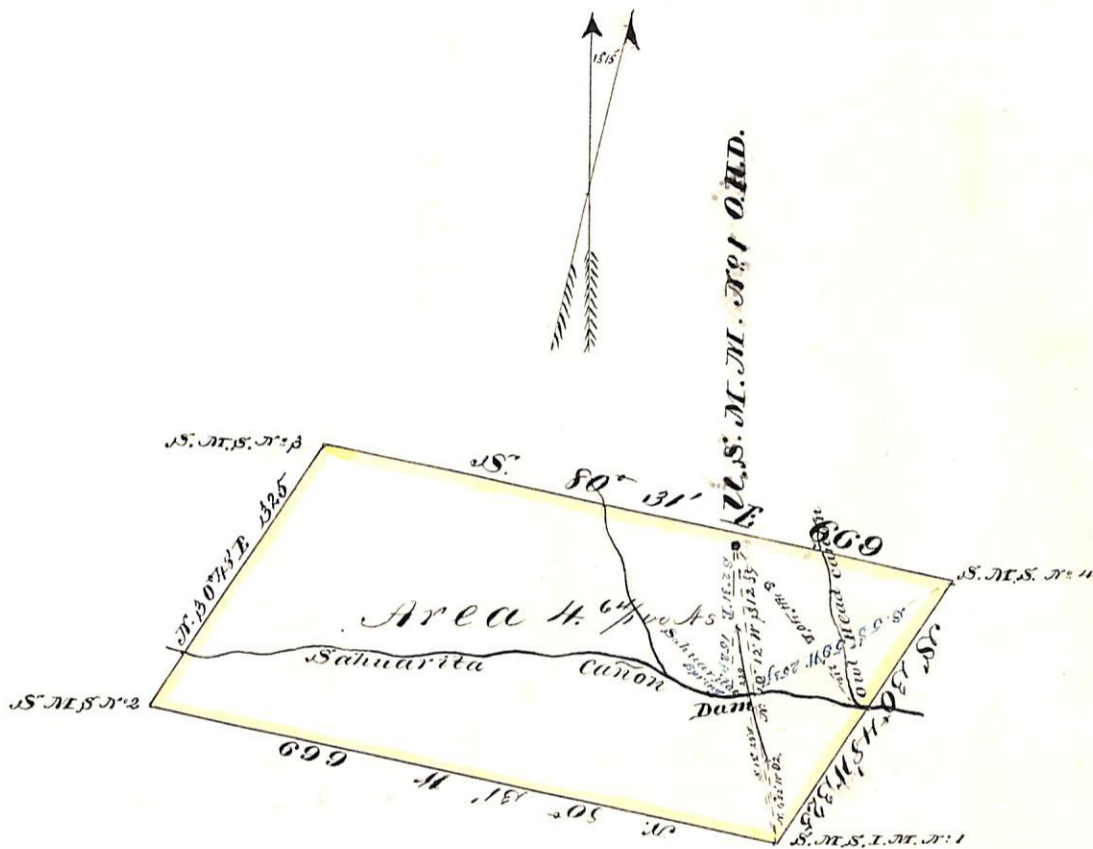
