of the

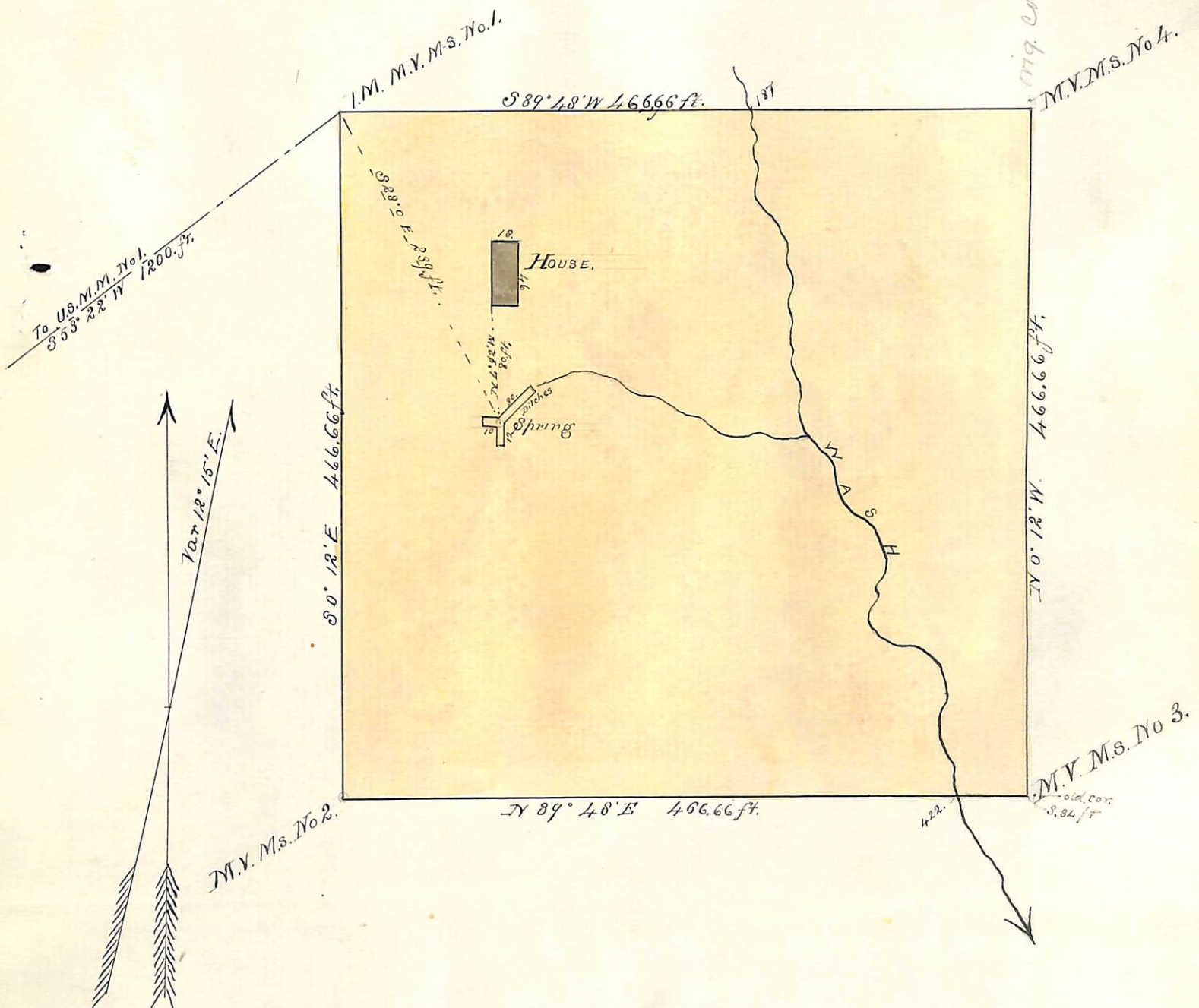
Monte Vista Mill-site Claim,
