Notice is hereby given that the undersigned in compliance with the requirements of the Mining Act of Congress approved May 10th 1872, has this day located and claimed 726 feet of ground in length by 600 feet wide as a mill site in connection with the Hoosier Mine - situated in the County of Gila - Globe District Arizona and more particularly described as follows to-wit:

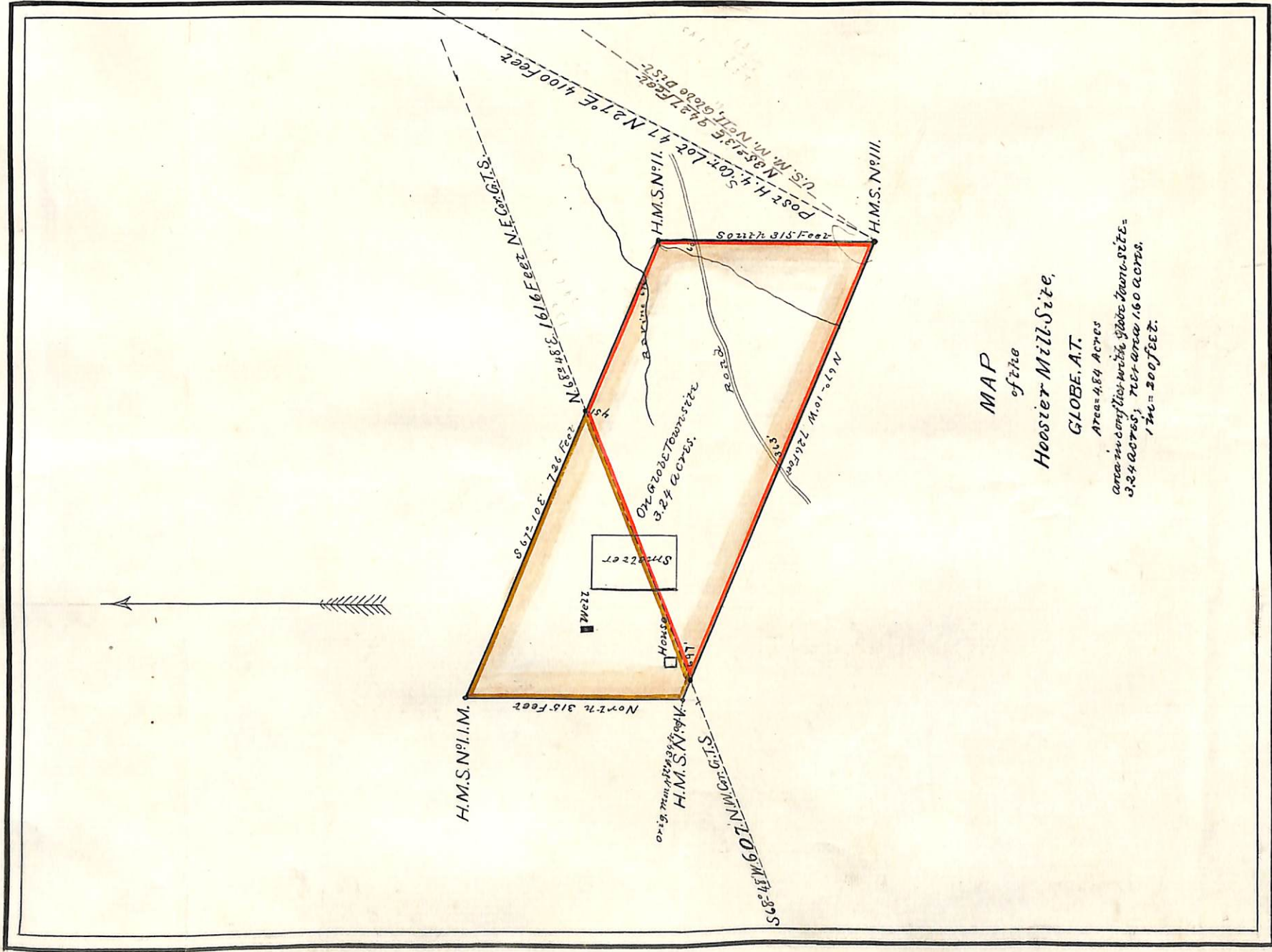
