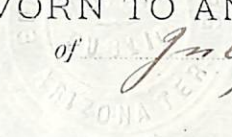

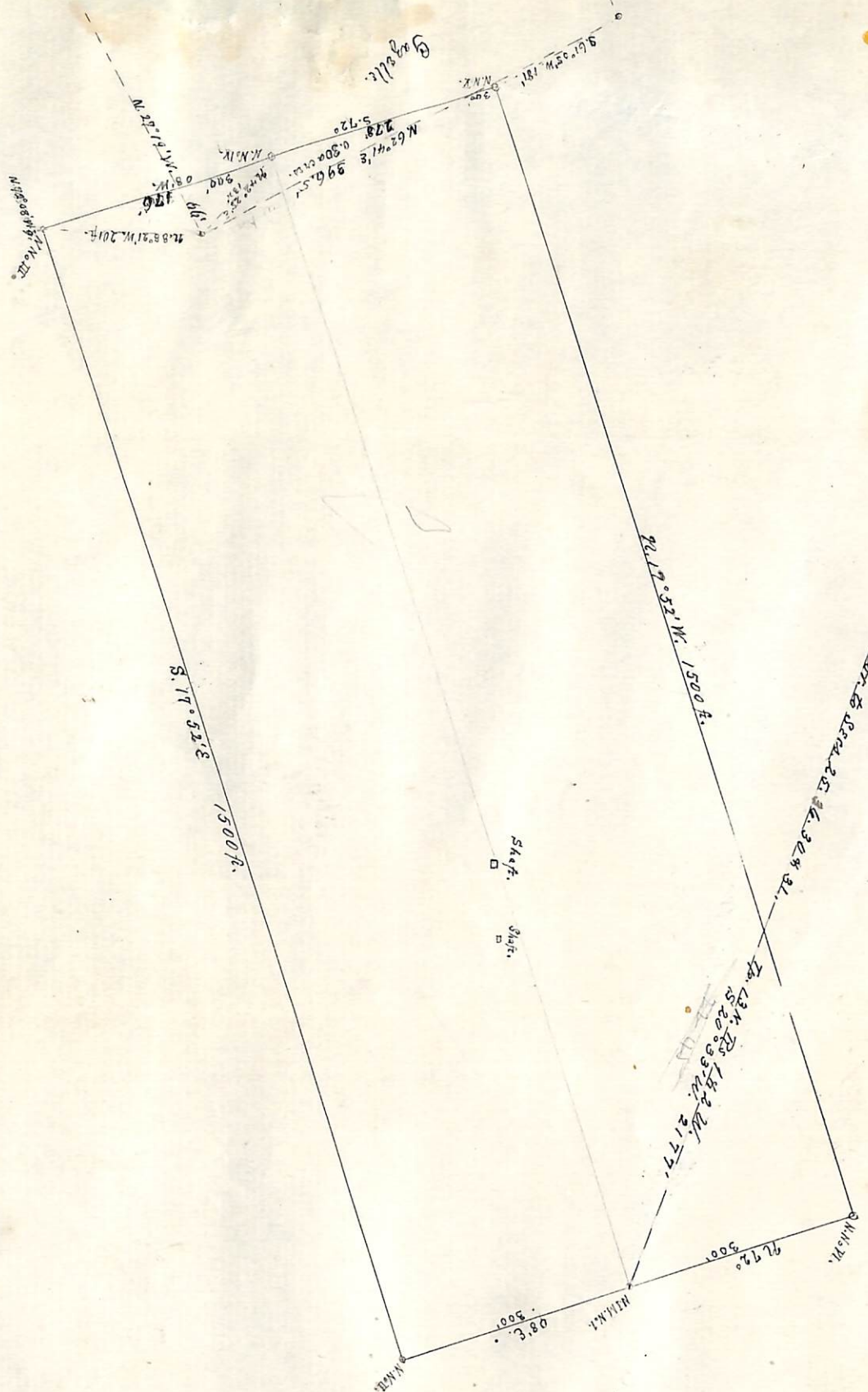

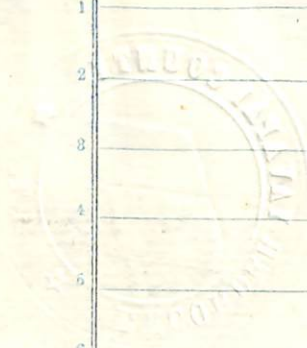

 Variation 13° 33' E. Scale 200 ft. = 1 inch.

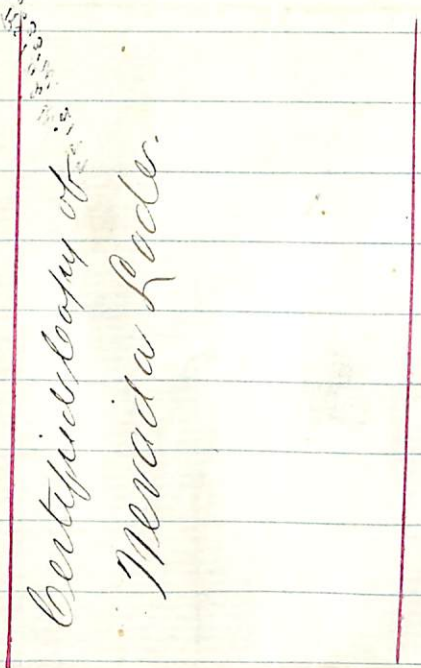
