Sibole Esq. to try all the issues therein and report a judgment thereon. The action was tried before said referee in accordance with said order of the court and agreement of counsel - John Haynes Esq and F. A. Burke Esq appeared as counsel for plaintiffs and Messrs Campbell Williams and Robinson as counsel for defendant. Witnesses on the part of plaintiffs and defendant were sworn and examined and documentary evidence was offered and received in evidence on the trial of said action. After argument of counsel the case was submitted to the referee and taken under advisement with the understanding between Counsel that the referee might file his finding and report a judgment; and that no further steps or proceedings should be

taken therein until the meeting of the above named court when a judgment should be rendered and entered by order of Court according to the finding and report of the referee.

That on or about the 26th day of August 1882 the referee filed his findings and reported a judgment therein in favor of the defendant and against the plaintiffs.

That before the meeting of said Court counsel for the plaintiffs filed herein written exceptions to said finding and gave notice of motion to require the referee to file additional findings which motion after argument of counsel was granted and a stay of all further proceedings was ordered by the Court until the further order of the

Court: that on or about the 30th day of Dec ad 1882, the referee filed said additional findings and reported a judgment therein in favor of the Defendant: that

on the 8th day of February 1883 on motion of counsel for defendant the above named court ordered a judgment to be rendered and entered herein according to the findings and report of referee.

Wherefore by reason of the law and the order of said Court and the findings and

report of the referee aforesaid it is ordered
