OF THE

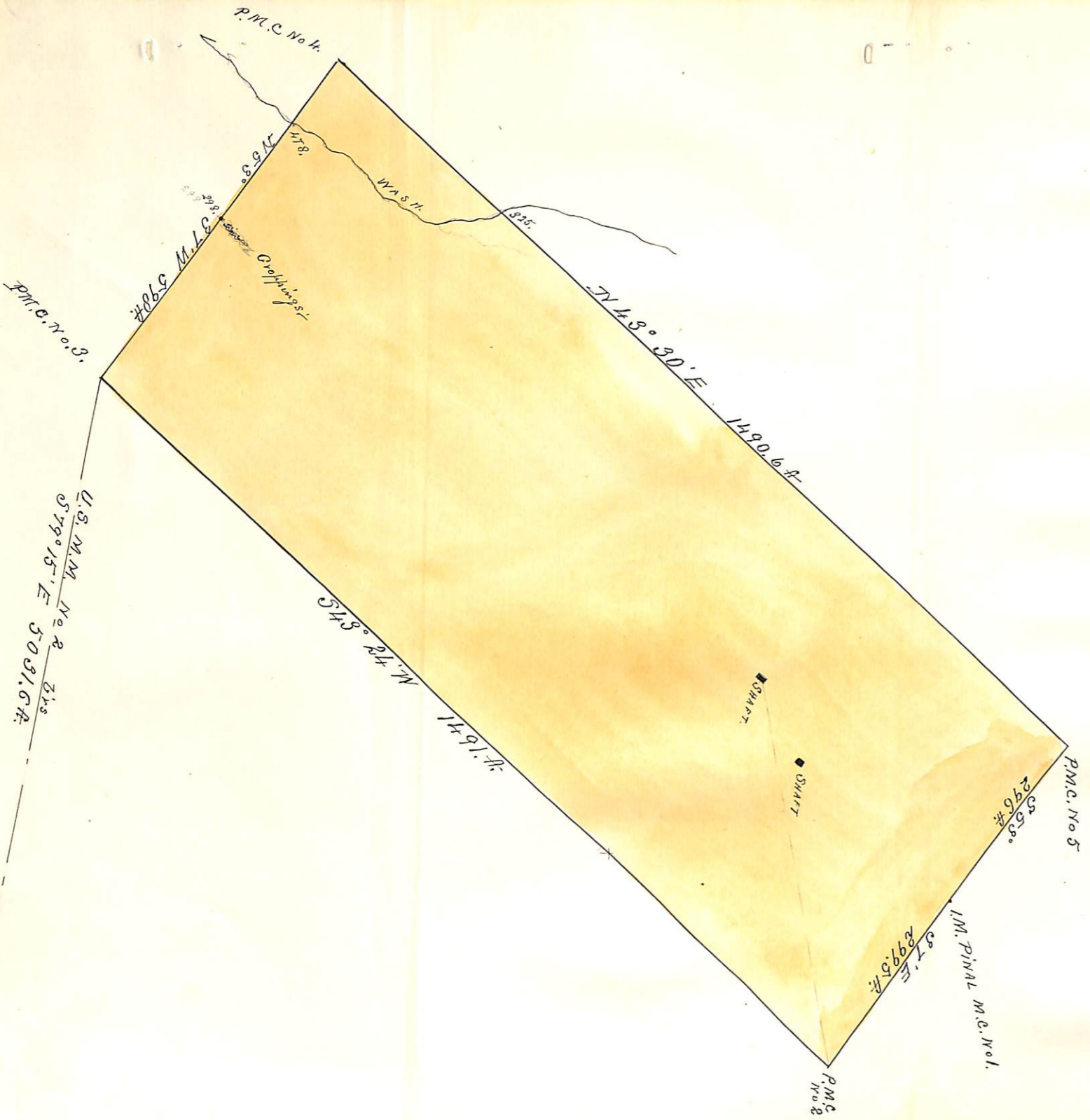
PINAL MINING CLAIM
