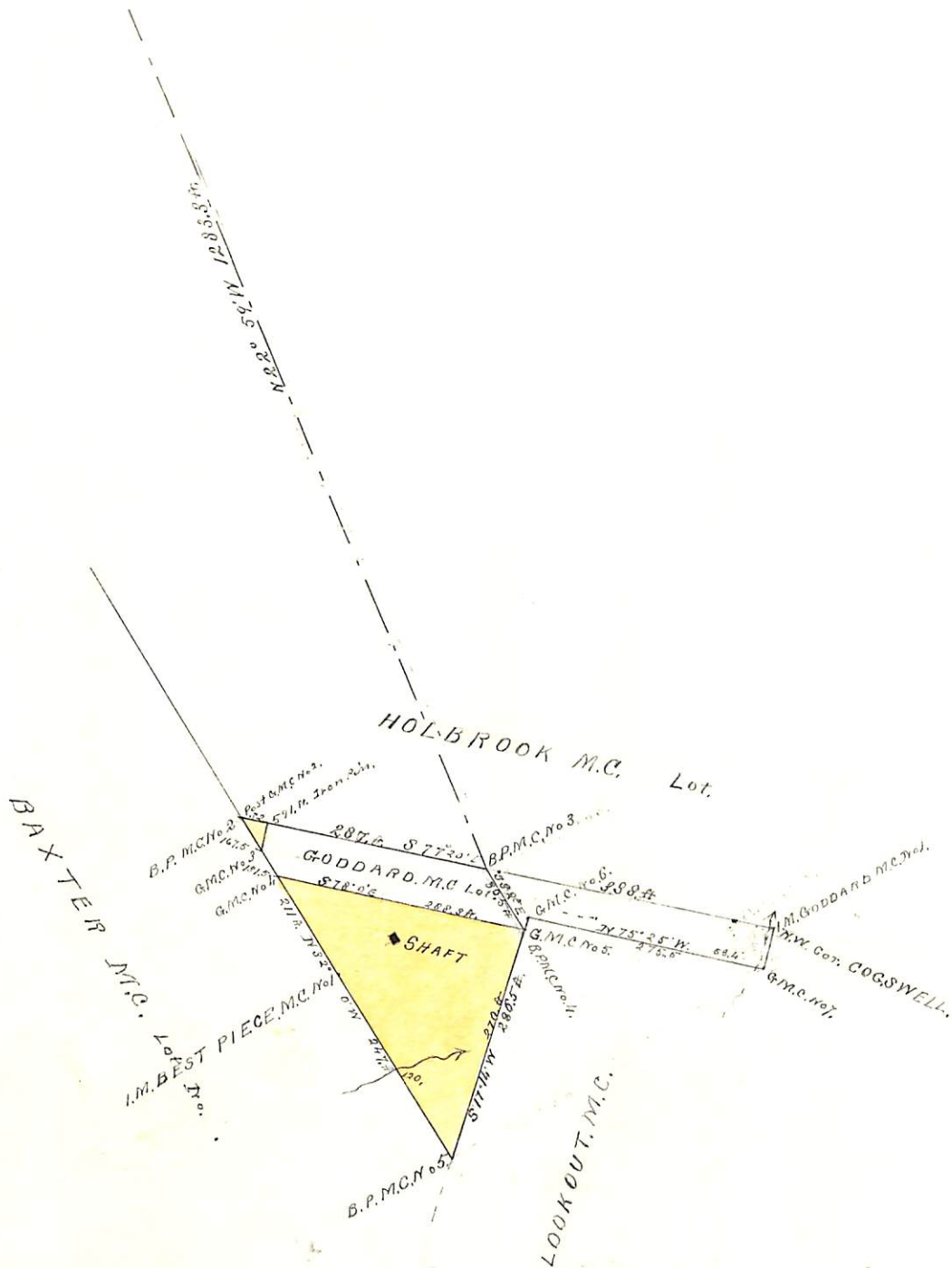
PLAT
