NOTICE OF MINING LOCATION.

Quartz Claim.

To all whom it may concern; This Mining Claim, the name of which is the Webfoot Mining Claim, situate on lands belonging to the United States of America and in which there are valuable mineral deposits, was entered upon and located for the purpose of exploration and purchase by Peter Meade and James Fitzpatrick, the undersigned on the first day of January, 1899.

The length of this claim is fifteen hundred feet and the claim runs seven hundred and twenty-five feet in a southerly direction and seven hundred and seventy-five feet in a northerly direction from the center of the discovery shaft, at which this notice is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with three hundred feet in width of the surface grounds, on each side of the center of said claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from the North West to the South East.

The claim is situated and located in the Hassayampia Mining District, in Yavapai County, in the Territory of Arizona, about five miles in a southerly direction from Prescott at Hermans station and is a relocation of the Humbolt Mine.
