Note. This group of claims extends along the south side of Cochise Hill, upon the north side of which the 14 claims of Survey No. 1872 are located. Upon the Bisbee lode of Survey No. 1872, a shaft known as shaft No. 2 has been sunk to a depth of 992 ft., which not only develops the nine other claims as is shown in the field notes of that survey but equally develops the ground embraced by the four claims of this survey. It has been proven by the experience of other mining companies operating in this district that the ore deposit, when they exist as deposits in the carboniferous line, are most economically developed by vertical sinking and crosscutting. This method of procedure explores as no other method would the ground wherein the ore bodies are known to exist. Consequently the ground on the S. slope of Cochise Hill which is embraced by the claims of this survey, must certainly be improved and developed by the southerly drift from Shaft No. 2 Bisbee lode Survey No. 1872, and hence an undivided interest in this shaft has been allotted to each of the claims of this group.

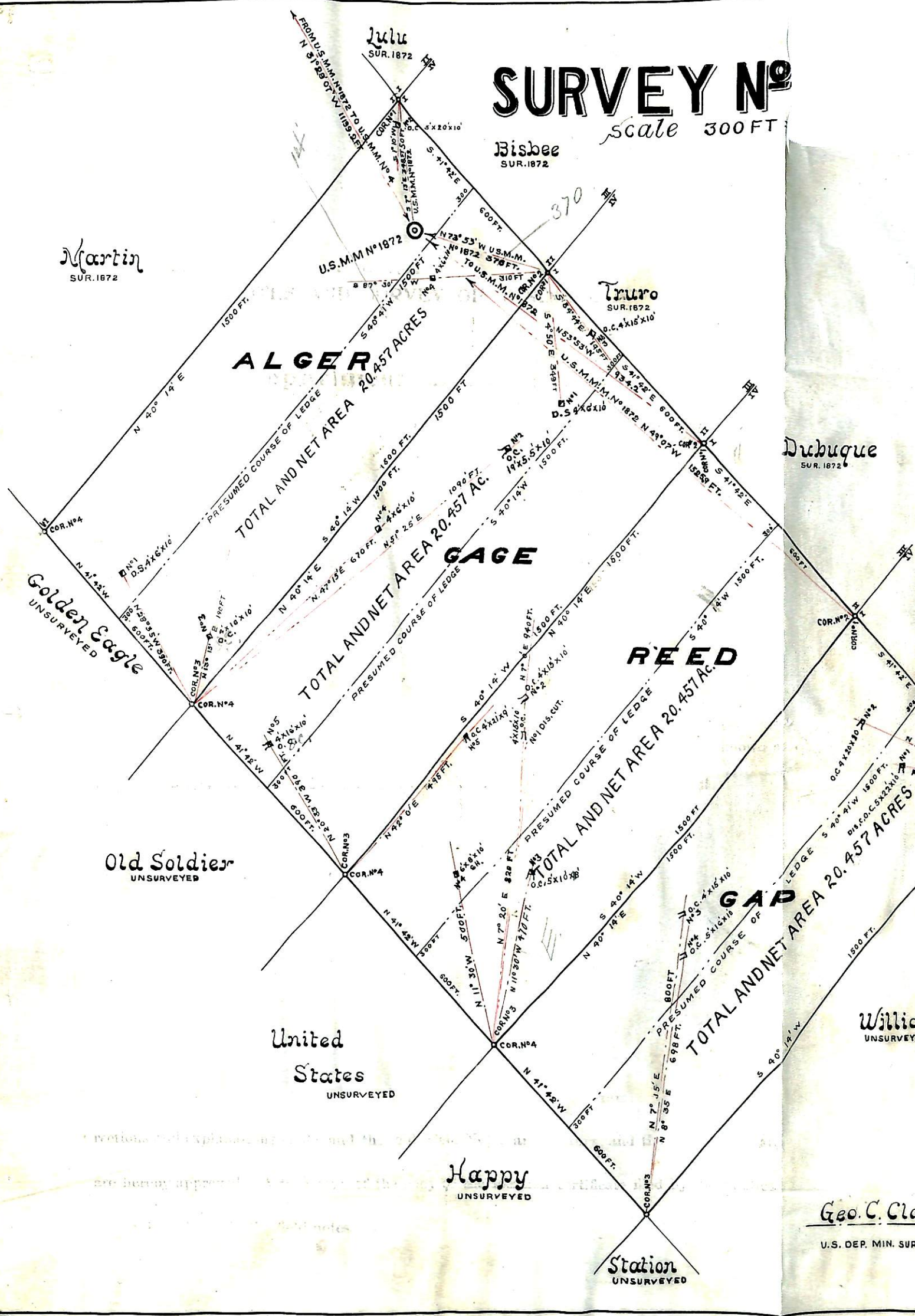

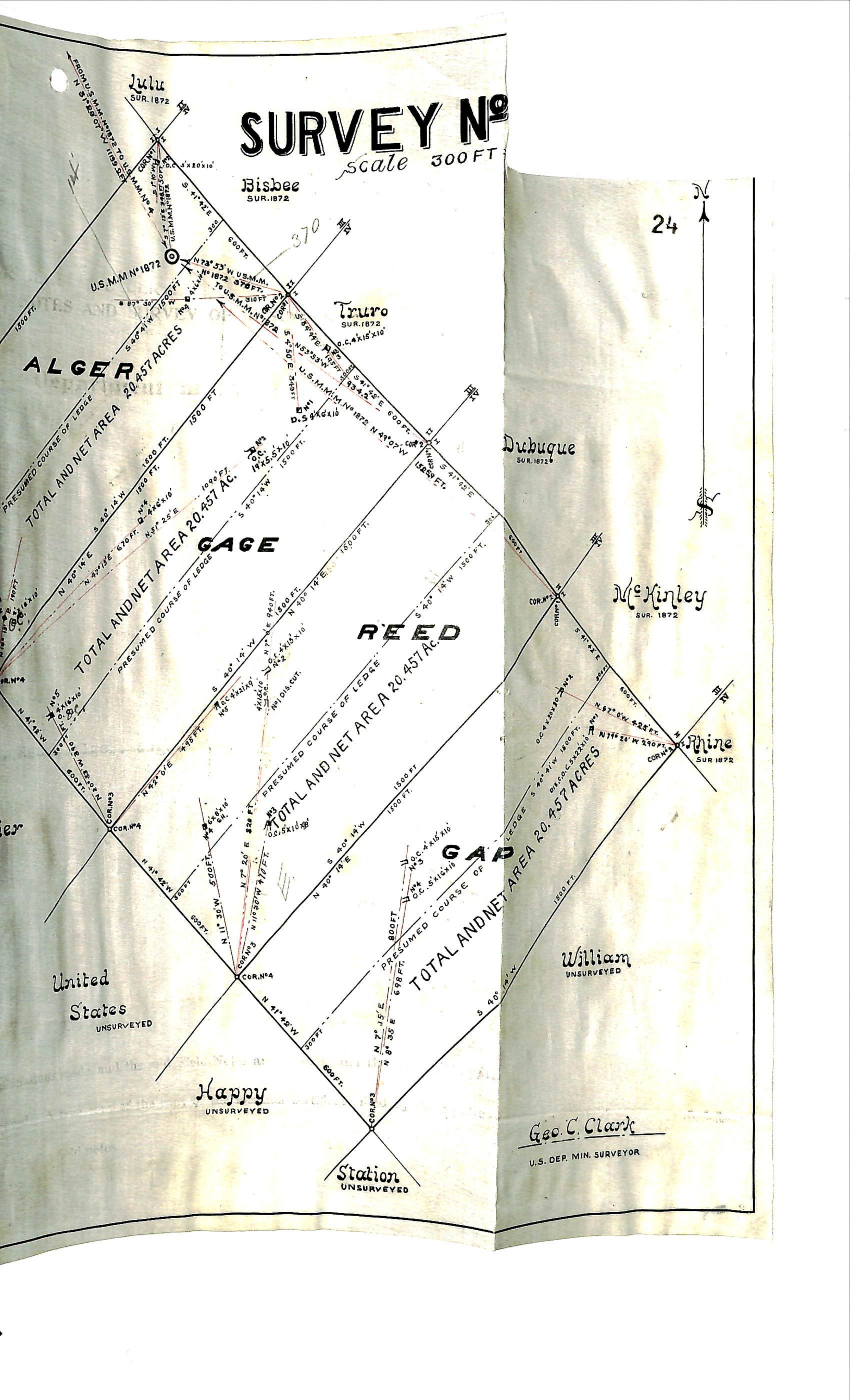
