

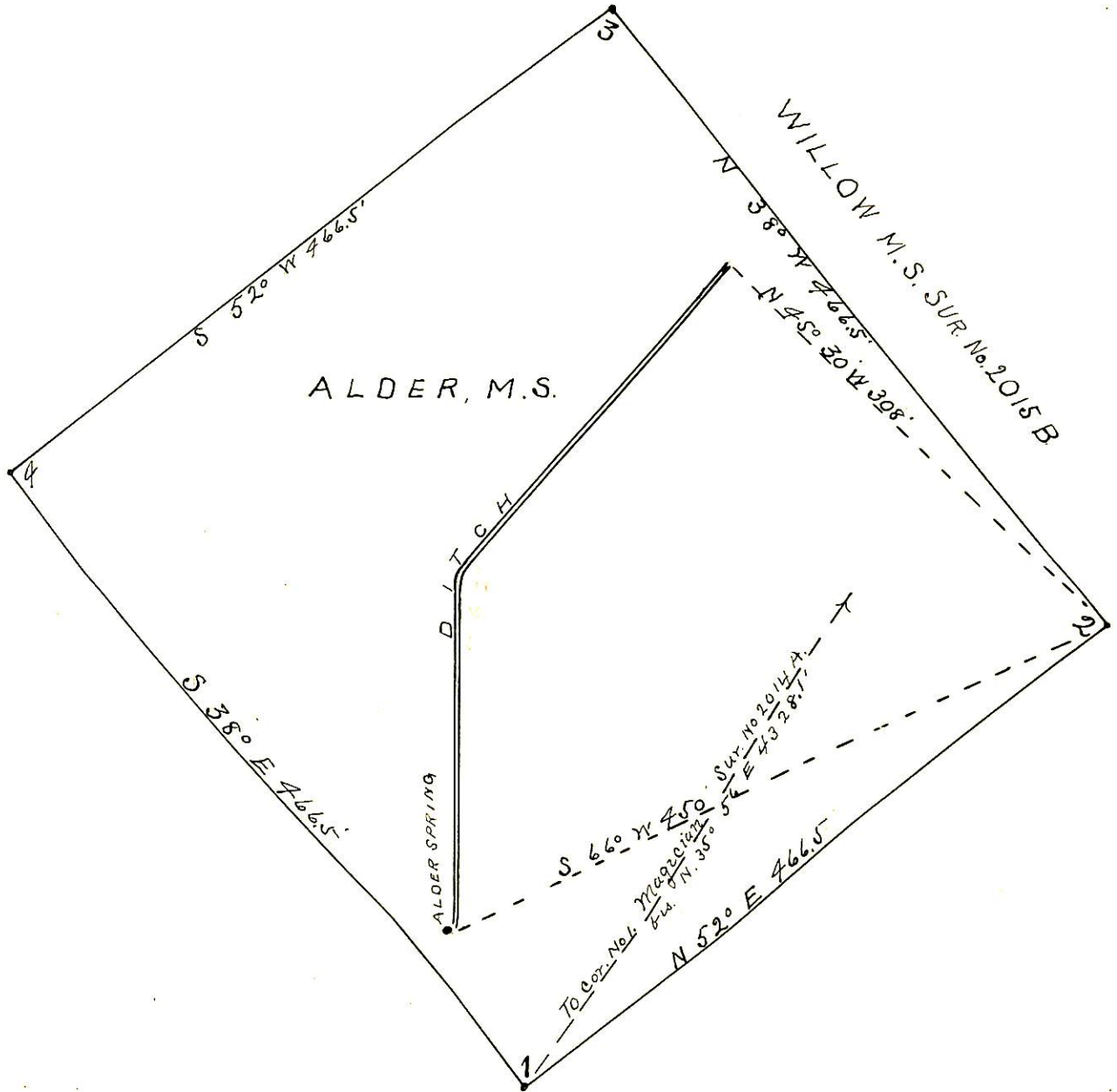

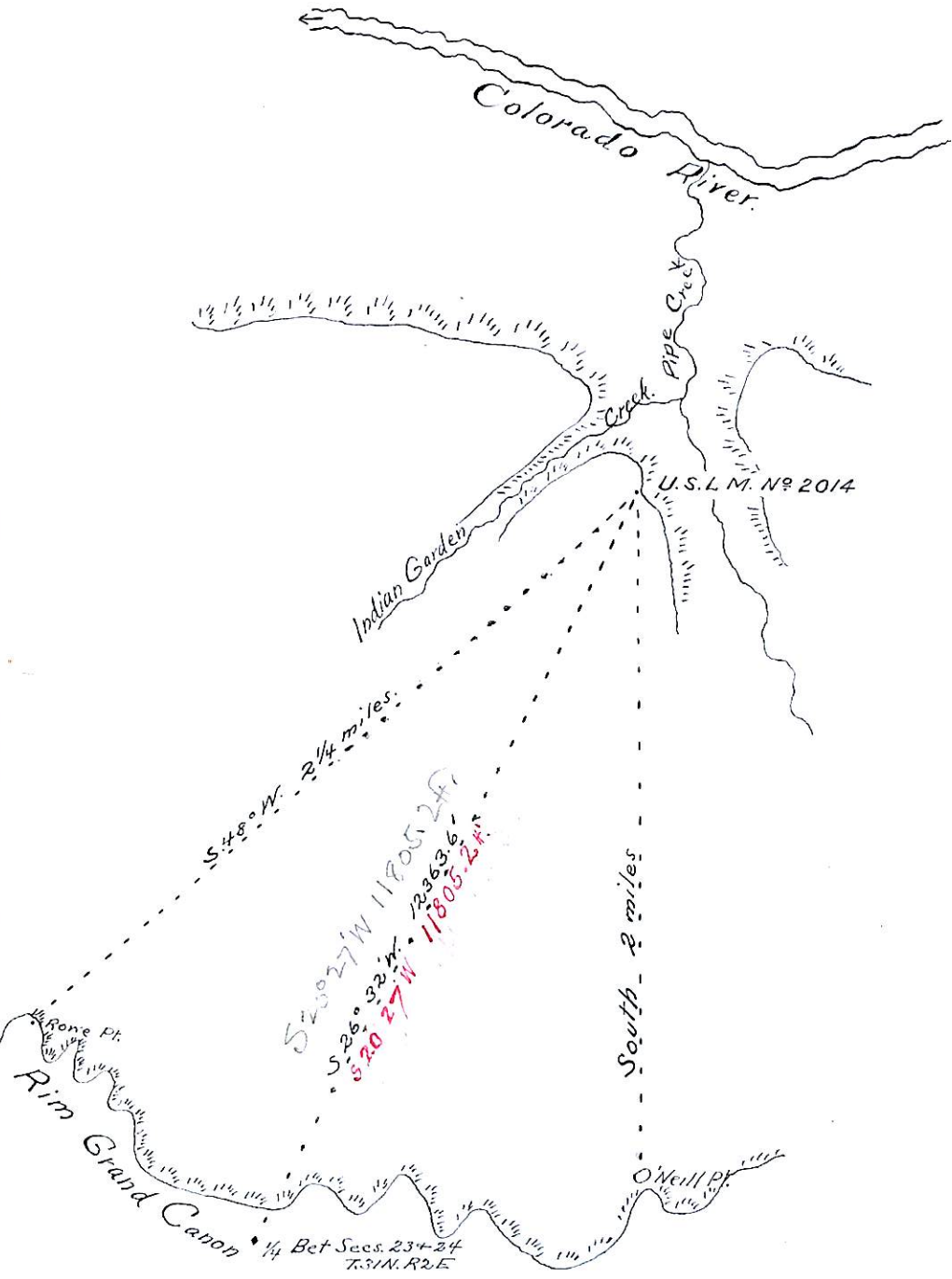
SURVEY No. 2014 B
PRESCOTT LAND DISTRICT.



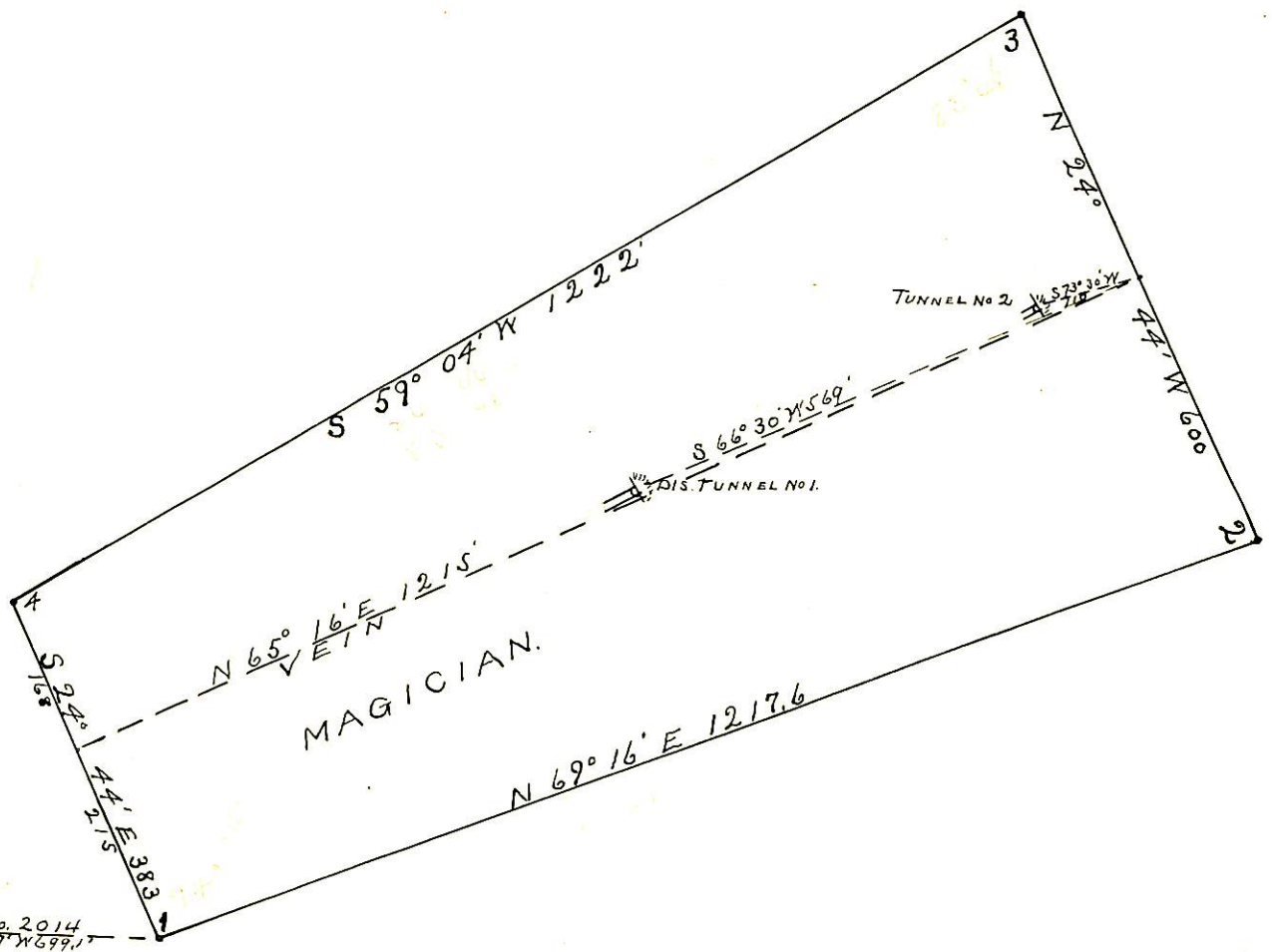
