Know all Men by these presents, that, this mining claim, the name of which is the Territorial mining claim, situated upon lands belonging to the United States, and in which there are valuable deposits of minerals, on the 1st day of January 1893, was discovered for the purpose of exploration and purchase by J. I. Williamson and that; Dan R. 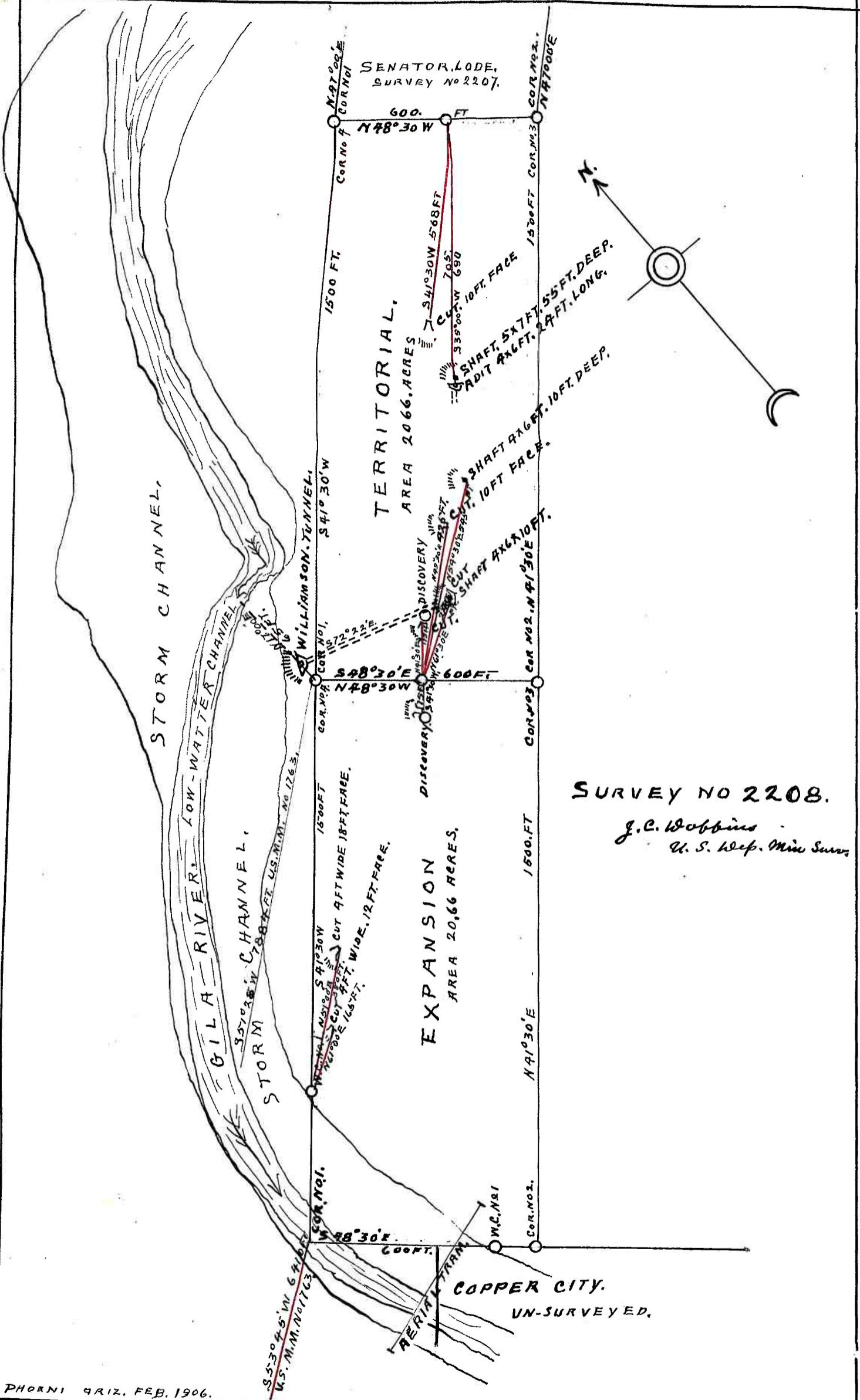
