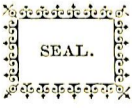

The length of this claim is Fifteen Hundred (1500) feet, and We claim Six Hundred (600) feet, in a North Easterly direction and Nine Hundred (900) feet in a South Westerly direction from the center of the discovery shaft, at which this notice is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with Three Hundred (300) feet in width of the surface grounds, on each side of the center of said claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from the North East to the South West

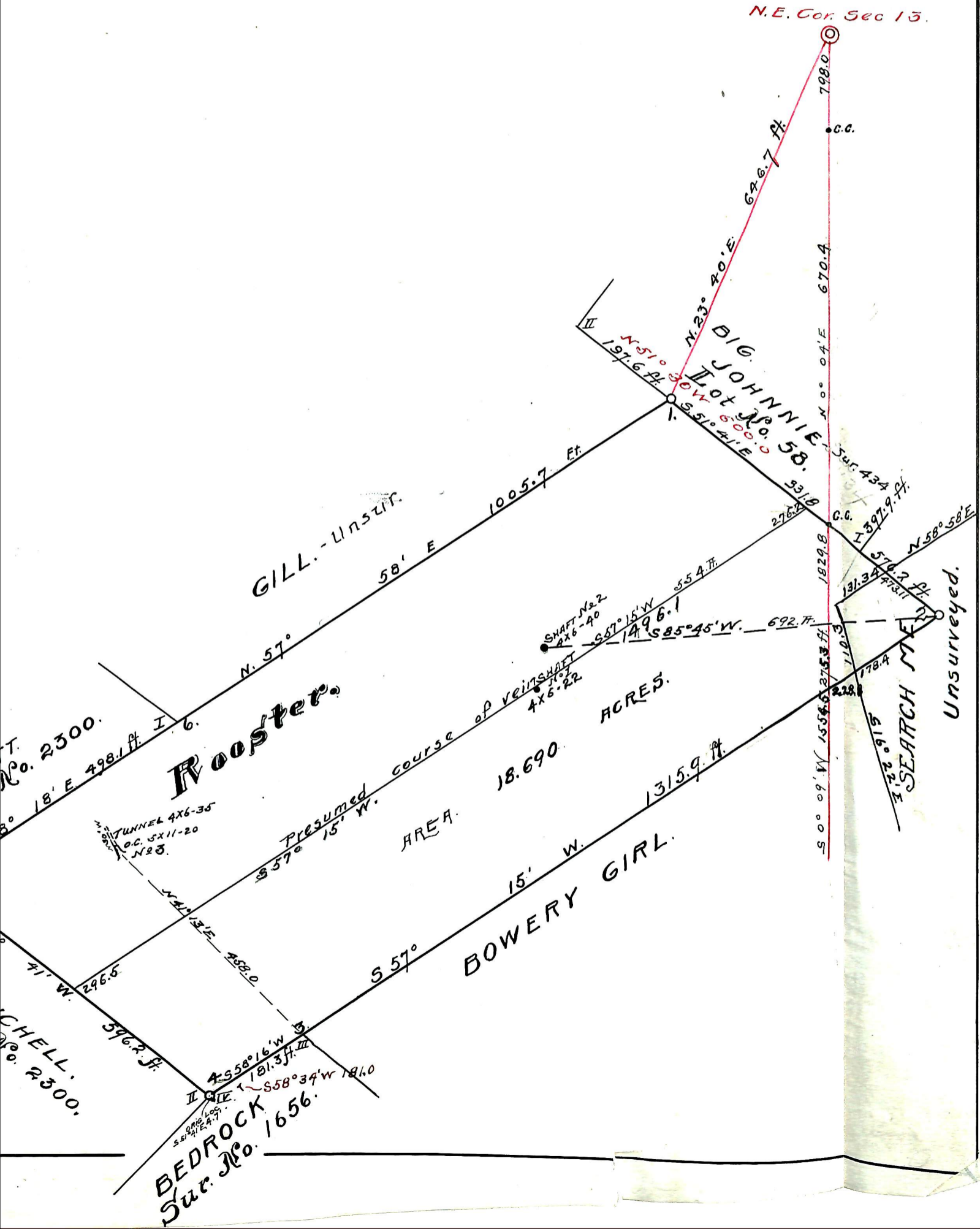
