Disagreements between the field notes of this survey and the location notice are due to errors in the latter. This survey was made with a Berger No. 6 mining transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 650 ft. steel tape.

Adjoining Claims.
