INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Buff and Berger Transit, The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 100-ft. and 500-ft. steel tapes.

Note- I find the following errors in former approved surveys. Line 4-1 survey No.2427, Prosperity lode, S. 49° 57' W., instead of S. 49° 58' W.

Line 1-2 and line 2-3, survey No.1315, Tub lode, N. 33° 41' 48" E. 587.76 ft., and S. 56° 18' 12" E. 1501.04 ft. instead of N. 32° 05' E. 600 ft. and S. 57° 55' E. 1500 ft. respectively.

The tie line from Cor. No.1, Survey No.1315, Tub lode, to Cor. to sec's 6-7-1-12, T. 22 N., Rs. 17 and 18 W. is S. 60° 17' W. 5095 ft. instead of S. 61° 18' W. 4983 ft. as given.

REPORT.

The lode line of this survey was run directly upon the ground, and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode line. All tie lines were run directly upon the ground.

Cor No.2 and Cor. No.3, Survey No.1315, Tub lode, are stone, properly monumented and chiseled with the No. of the corner and survey.

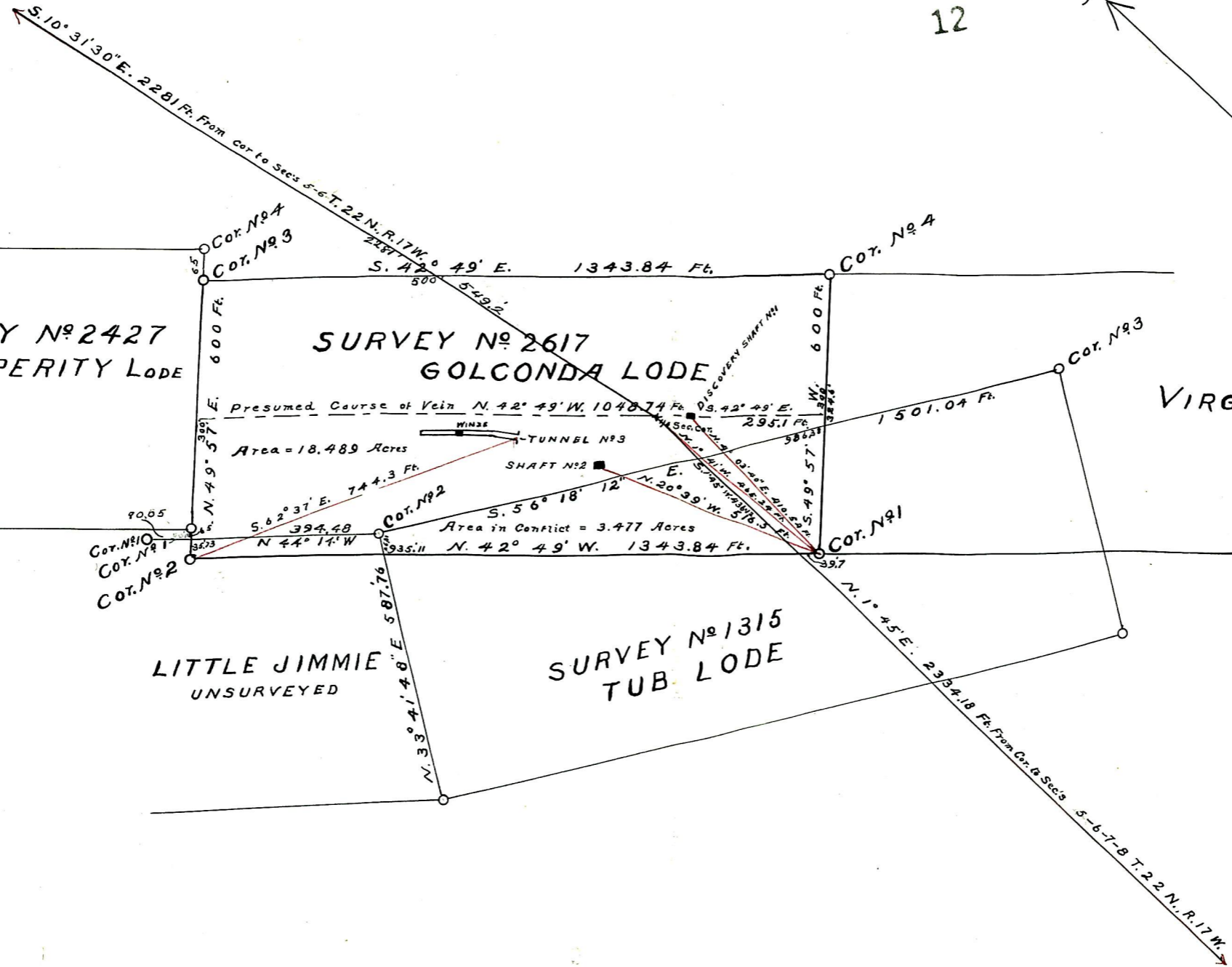
