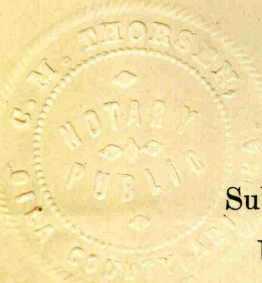

AMENDED NOTICE OF LOCATION.

MAY 17 1909

Notice is Hereby Given, that on the First day of January 1902 the undersigned George W. Margroum, a citizen of the United States, prospected for, and entered upon and located the Paul Jones mining claim, containing mineral bearing quartz, earth or rock in place, on the public domain of the United States and the same was located for mining purposes.

The said claim being 1499 ft in length and 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein at the Westerly end and 299.5 feet on each side of the center of the vein at the Easterly end for the full length of the claim. The general course of this lode, deposit or premises is from the North east to the South West.

The claim is situated in Globe Mining District, Gila County, Territory of Arizona, about five miles in a Northerly direction from the town of Globe and one half mile northwesterly from the Gipsy Wells, The whole of this claim is located as forfeited and abandoned property.
