The adjoining claims are, to the east end. The Amalgamated Copper Survey No 2418. F X O'Brien owner, this cuts off a fraction from the King Solomon No 1 Lode.

## Topography

## Report

The lode lines of each location of this claim was run directly upon the ground and the several corners were established by means of offsets from the lode lines.

The U.S.L.M. 1477 is the nearest land mark. This monument is built of stones and about 7 ft high and 5 ft in diameter with a round post in the center is in good condition, the marked post is split off and standing alongside the monument.
