The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by observation on Polaris. The variation at all corners is 15° E. The distances were measured with 100 ft and 300 ft steel tapes.

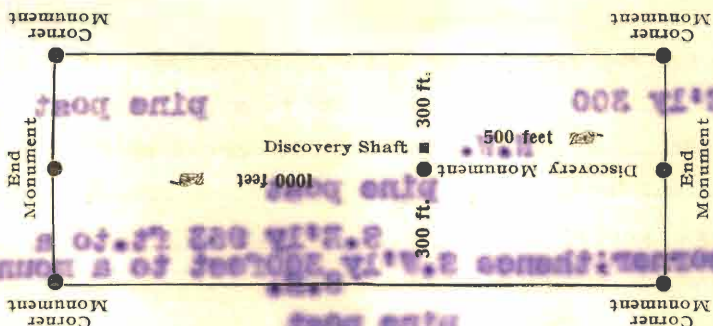
