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transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct Polaris observation.

The distances were measured with a 650 ft. steel tape.

The quarter corner between sections 24 and 25 to which tie is given is a quartzite stone  $5 \times 5 \times 3$  ins. out of the ground, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$ -S-24, on the north face.

Cor. No.4, Globe Ledge Lode, Lot 30, to which tie is given is a 4 x 4 pine post, set in concrete; flush with the surface of the ground, in railroad track.

Survey#2849B, Globe Millsite:

This is an unapproved survey. Corners and 5 are as described herein.

The disagreement between the notes of this survey and the location notice is due to errors in the latter.
