INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a W. & L. E. Gurley Mountain transit fitted with a Burt solar by which the true meridian was obtained and checked upon previously determined courses. Measurements were made with a 400 foot steel tape.

This survey is tied to the W 1/4 cor. of section 19 it being impossible in the field to find the N.W. corner of section 19, the theoretical point for such corner being North 2640 ft. from the W. 1/4 Cor. of Sec. 19. All lines of this survey were run directly upon the ground.

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This Mining Claim, the name of which is the PROSPECT Mining Claim, situate on lands belonging to the United States of America, and in which there are valuable mineral deposits, was entered upon and located for the purposes of exploration and purchased by Warrior Copper Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the Territory of Arizona, the undersigned, on the 15th. day of February, 1911.

The length of this claim is 1495 feet and said corporation claims 312 feet in a N. 73° 50' E. direction and 1183 feet in a S. 73° 50' W. direction from the center of the discovery shaft, at which this notice is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with 300 feet in width of the surface grounds on each side of the center of said claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from the Northeast to the Southwest.

The claim is situated and located in the Globe Mining District, in Gila County, in the Territory of Arizona, about one half mile in a westerly direction from Black Warrior postoffice, and is bounded on the west by the Shorty lode and on the south by the Red Raven lode.
