## TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This Mining Claim, the name of which is the NUGGET Mining Claim, situate on lands belonging to the United States of America, and in which there are valuable mineral deposits, was entered upon and located for the purpose of exploration and purchase by Loos Henry, John Cole & Fred Sattes the undersigned, on the 24th day of January 1900

The length of this claim is 1500 feet, and we claim 200 feet, in a Southerly direction and 1300 feet in a Northerly direction from the center of the discovery shaft, at which this notice is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with 300 feet in width of the surface grounds, on each side of the center of said claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from the North to the South

The claim is situated and located in the Slate Creek Mining District, in Yavapai County, in the Territory of Arizona, about four hundred (400) feet in a North Westerly direction from the Blue Dick Mine
