
These claims have not been filed with the Arizona State Office, Bureau of Land Management, in accordance with Section 314, 90 STAT. 2769, (43 U.S.C. 1744).

This cancellation was necessitated to clear the record.

The Mineral Survey Plat should be noted as follows:

"Geyser, Geyser No. 1 and Geyser No. 2 lodes, M.S. 2957, were canceled April 2, 2002, by memo 9605 (956) M.S. 2957, which is now a part of the original field notes."
