The group of thirty three lodes, known as the Coronado Mine, claimant herein, of which this claim is a part, lies on the divide between Chase Creek and the Eagle River, the former being the principal means of egress from the Copper Mountain Mining District, and is the natural outlet from the Coronado Mine, via the Little Coronado Railroad to Metcalf, and thence over the Coronado Railroad to the Smelter, at Clifton, Arizona,

The thirty three lodes, embraced in the Coronado Mine are one contiguous group and are being advantageously developed, owing to the natural topography of the country, by means of the Matilda Shaft, on the Matilda lode Lot.
