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Location.

This survey is located partially in the South half of Sec. 26, T.3 N., R.14 E., G.& S.R.B.& M., and partially in the unsurveyed North half of said Sec. 26, Globe Mining District, Gila County, Arizona, in the Crook National Forest.

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Instrument and Determination of Meridian.

This survey was made with a 6¼ inch Berger Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct Solar observation. The distances were measured with a 650 ft. steel tape.

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Adjoining and Conflicting Claims.

Unappropriated land on the north, east and west. H.E. No.07593, owned by Robert Pringle; and the Caravel and Americus Mill Sites, ^{unsurveyed} owned by the claimant of the claims in this survey, on the south.

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Report.

The lines of the claims in this survey were run direct upon the ground.

The quarter corner between Sections 25 and 26, T.3 N., R.14 E., G.& S.R.B.& M., to which ties are given, is a dacite stone chiseled ¼ on west face, showing .6 x 1 x 1 ft. out of the ground, with mound of stone alongside.

The section corner common to Sections 25, 26, 35 and 36, T.3 N., R.14 E., G.& S.R.B.& M., to which ties are given is a dacite stone chiseled with one groove on the south face and one groove on the east face, showing .5 x .6 x

.7 ft. out of the ground, with mound of stone alongside.

The north boundary of H.E.No.07593, I establish by subdividing the south half of Section 26, which I traversed around, beginning at the S.E.Cor. of said section and running thence S.89°-59' W. 2640.0 ft. to S. $\frac{1}{4}$ corner, thence N.89°-58' W. 2646.5 ft. to S.W.Cor.; thence N.00°-02' W. 2637.6 ft. to W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor.; thence S.89°-52' E. 5295.4 ft. to E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor.; thence S.00°-10' W. 2626.1 ft. to the place of beginning. From this data I establish the N.E.Corner of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 26, N.00°-10' E. 1313.1 ft. from the S.E.Cor., from which I establish the N.E. and N.W.Corners, respectively, of H.E.No. 07593, ^{being the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ said Sec. 26,} N.89°-57' W. 661.0' and 1322.0 ft.

Cor. No.1, Columbia lode and Cor. No.1, Clipper lode, of Sur.2379; Cor. No.1, Copper Wonder lode, Cor. No.1, Colorado lode and Cor. No.1, Monte Christo Copper lode, of Sur. 2656, to which ties are given, respectively from Corners No.1 of each the Columbia, Clipper, Copper Wonder, Colorado and Monte Christo mill sites, are 4 x 4 posts properly set and scribed.

The disagreement between these notes and the location notices is due to errors in the latter.


