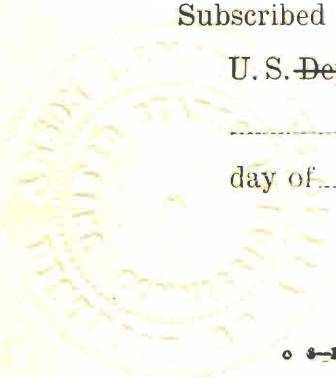
FINAL OATH OF U. S. DEPUTY MINERAL SURVEYOR

THE ROOSEVELT MILL-SITE CLAIM AND WATER RIGHT.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I the undersigned, have this day located a Mill-Site for the purpose of erecting suitable works for reducing the ores of the Roosevelt Mining Claim, situated in Music Mountain Mining District, Mohave County, Arizona Territory, the exterior boundaries of said Roosevelt, Mill--Site Claim are as follows, viz:

Commencing at a monument of stone at N. E. corner of claim, and running thence in a westerly direction, 466½ feet to monument of stone at N. W. corner of claim, thence in a southerly direction 466½ feet to Monument of stone at S. W. corner of claim, thence in an easterly direction 466½ feet to monument of stone at S. E. corner of claim, thence in a northerly direction, 466½ feet to Monument of stone at N. E. corner of claim and place of beginning.

This location may be more generally described as being situated in the Music Mountains, six miles North Easterly direction from the said Roosevelt mine and about (28) twenty eight miles Northerly from the town of Hackberry and is know on the Clay Springs Ranch.
