LOCATION.

This survey is located in the Tombstone Mining District, Cochise County, Arizona in Sections 13, 14, 23 and 24 T 20 S., R 22 E. G & S R B & M.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger & Sons No 1 C transit. The course were deflected from the true meridian as determined by a Solar observation. The distances were measured with a 300 foot steel tape. Magnetic Variation 12° 15' East at all corners.

REPORT.

Cor for Secs 13, 14, 23 and 24; T 20 S., R 22 E., is a limestone rock 7 x 8 x 6 ins high above ground, chiseled III on south face, I on east face. A monument of rocks 4 feet west.

1/4 Cor between Secs 13 and 14 is a quartzite rock 6 x 7 x 20 ins high, not set in ground, but in small monument of rocks. Chiseled 1/4 on west face. A monument of rocks 5 feet west.

1/4 Cor between Secs 13 and 24 is a X and 1/4 chiseled on a limestone ledge with a 72 x 36 ins exposure. A monument of rocks 2 feet north of X.
