Transit. The courses were deflected from the true
meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The
distances were measured with 100 ft and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Report.

The lode line of this location was run direct upon the ground, and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode line; all tie lines were run direct upon the ground, ^{or} calculated through direct ties to former official surveys made by me.

U.S.L.M.No.1602 is a basalt stone 8x15x14 ins. above the ground, properly set, chiseled with a cross (X) and U.S.L.M.No.1602 chiseled on south face.

The corner of Sections 22-23-26-27 unapproved, T.19 N.,R.20 W. G & S.R. B& M is a 2 in.iron pipe with brass cap, properly set and marked.

Sur.No.3190 York Annex and Bunker Hill lodes.

All corners and End centers are pine posts 4 ft. long, 4 ins.square, properly set and marked.

Sur.No.3196 Starlight lode.

All corners and end centers are porphyry stones, properly set and marked.
