On both legs of the lode line of the Sunny Side Extension No.1 lode, mineral bearing crevices of calcite and spar are exposed, conforming with the course of the lode line. The irregularity of the lode lines in this survey may demand explanation: These claims were amongst

Feet. the first locations in this end of the district and the locator anxious to comply with the exact meaning of the mining law, made the locations conform with the outcrop of the veins, This irregularity is due to the outcropping of a vein(dipping 50 to 70 degrees) on a steep mountain side which is in turn cut by a rugged gulch on the Sunny Side Extension No.1 lode.

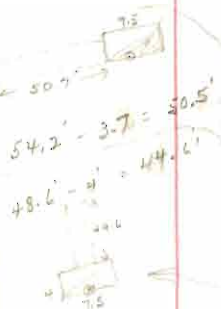

INSTRUMENT AND DETERMINATION OF MERIDIAN

This survey was made with an Ainsworth Engineers transit.

The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations.

The distances were measured with 100 and 500 ft. steel tapes.

REPORT.

The side and end lines of the claims in this survey and all tie lines were run direct upon the ground.

The S.W. Cor. of Secs^{25 31&36} 30; T.19 N; R^{&20} 19 W., to which tie is given consists of a lava rock, 7x7 ins. 12 ins. above the ground, 5 notches chiseled on the Northerly side and indications of one notch on the Southerly side.

The West $\frac{1}{2}$ Cor. of Secs^{&26} 25; T.19 N; R.20 W., ~~unap-~~proved, to which tie is given consists of a one inch black iron pipe, stamped $\frac{1}{2}$ S26 S25.

All corners of the Lodestone lode uns. consist of 4x4 ins. redwood posts properly set and marked.

All corners of the Bullion lode uns. consist of 4x4 ins. pine posts, properly set and marked.

On my connected sheet the S.W. Cor. of Sec.30, platted from this survey, does not agree with the reported position of same. By rechecking my work I find the latter in error.

The disagreement between these notes and the notices of amended location is due to error in the latter.


