No. 1. The discovery cut, the face of which being the discovery point is on the lode line 128.70 ft. from a point on line 4-3 45.95 ft. from Cor. No. 4, 5 ft. wide 8 ft. face running  $N 71^{\circ} 28' E$  10 ft to mouth.

From the face is a tunnel 5 x 7 ft running  $S 71^{\circ} 28' E$  50 ft to its face.

Instrument

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger & Sons mining transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 600 ft. steel tapes.

Report

The lines of this claim were run by a closed traverse around the claim and the corners of the conflicting claims tied in from the several traverse points.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor. between Sec's 26 & 27 T. 16 N. R. 26. G. & S. R. G. & M. is a 1 in. iron pipe projecting 10 in. above the ground, topped by a brass cap on which is stamped  $\frac{27}{\frac{1}{4}} 26$

Sur. No. 869 Venture No. 1 North lode.

Cor. No. 5 is a 2 in. iron pipe set in a hole drilled in solid rock and cemented in place. The center of the pipe being the point for corner where the cross marked the spot.

The rock is marked V. N. No 5 and G. S. No. 1. 1285

Cor No 6 is a concrete monument similar to Cor. No. 1. Venture East lode this survey and replaces the projecting rock on which was marked + V.N. No. 6 and V.S. No. 6.

The numbers of the surveys 869 and 870 will be stamped on the brass disk in addition to the markings on the stone.

I find line 5-6 to be  $S 52^{\circ} 18' E$  instead of  $S 52^{\circ} E$  as reported.

## Survey No. 1285 Gun Sight lode.

Cor. 1 is identical with Cor. 5 of Sur No 869 Venture No. 1 North lode previously described.

Cor 2 is identical with Cor No 2 Venture East lode this survey, and Cor 3 is identical with Cor. No. 4 of the Venture East lode this survey, both previously described.

Cor 4 is a concrete monument similar to Cor No 1 of the Venture East lode this survey and replaces the cross for corner on rock in place that was marked G-4-1285 and No 99-3-1285.

Cor No 2 (stone corner) was also marked C No 1 in addition to G. S. No. 2, 1285; on the concrete monument the C. No. 1 is omitted.

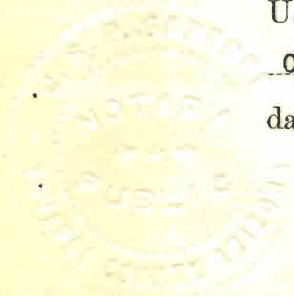

The length of this claim is three hundred (300) feet, and we claim one hundred fifty (150) feet, in a southwesterly direction and one hundred fifty (150) feet in a northeasterly direction from the center of the discovery cut at which this notice is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with two hundred (200) feet in width of the surface grounds, on each side of the center of said claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from the northeast to the southwest.
