Improvement No.3, above described, was started by the claimant company, as the working shaft to develop the Pilot and Parrett lodes; The Contention and Contention No.1 lodes were acquired by purchase; Subsequent to the purchase of these claims, the shaft was sunk from a depth of 165 ft. to 400 ft., at which depth it is at least 300 ft. below the surface of each of the claims in this group. The claimant company proposes by crosscutting and drifting, from this shaft, toward and under each of the claims, to develop and mine them, This plan of development is consistent with good mining.

The value of this improvement is therefore distributed equally to the four claims in this group, \$7750 being credited to each.

The North 1/4 Cor. of Sec. 33; T. 19 N; R. 20 W., has been washed out.

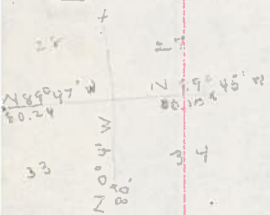

NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF MINERAL SURVEY

The Pilot, Parrett, Contention, and Contention No. 1 lodes, Mineral Survey No. 3542, located in sections 28, 33 and 34, Township 19 North, Range 20 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona, are hereby canceled.

These claims have not been filed with the Arizona State Office, Bureau of Land Management, in accordance with Section 314, 90 STAT. 2769, (43 U.S.C. 1744).

This cancellation was necessitated to clear the record.

The Mineral Survey Plat should be noted as follows:
