Instrument and Meridian

iron pipes, firmly set and properly marked.

Cors. No. 1 and 2, Beuleeard lode, Sur. No. 1368 are the only corners in said survey that seem to be in place. Prior to the time of this survey, I tried to retrace the lines of Sur. No. 1368 and it is evident to


me that the two corners above mentioned are the only corners ever set as the topography as given in the field notes does not agree at any point and the monuments found were the original location monuments and do not agree with any system of courses or distances.

The west end line of the claim in this survey is identical, as near as can be determined, with the east end line of the Lady Bright lode.

Adjoining and Conflicting Claims

This survey is bounded on the west by the Lady Bright lode and south by the Beuleeard lode, Sur. No. 1368 and on the north and east by Public Domain.

There are no known conflicts.
