This survey is located on unsurveyed ground which when surveyed will be approximately Secs. <sup>11 & 12</sup> 29 & 30, T 5 N., R <sup>17</sup> 18 E, G & S.R. B & M. within the boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation about 1½ mile northerly from the Peninsula Bend on Salt River.

INSTRUMENT:

This survey was made with a Berger transit. The course was deflected from a true meridian as determined by an observation on Polaris at its western elongation. The distance was measured with a 100 and 300 foot steel tape.

ADJOINING CLAIMS:

Min. Sur. No. 3823 is bounded on the east by Sur. No. 3808, on the south by Sur. No. 3807 and on the west by Sur. 3812.

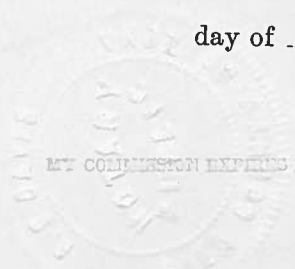


