Instrument,

This survey was made with a Gurley Light Mountain Transit, the courses were deflected from the meridian as determined from direct Solar observations, The distances were measured with a five hundred and a fifty foot steel tapes.

Report,

The lode line of each of the locations of this claim was run direct upon the ground and the several corners were established by offsets therefrom. The tie lines were run direct upon the ground.

This claim is located on rolling ground, and shaft No.1 Ruby Silver North lode, the common improvement, is so located that by sinking and drifting both lodes in this claim may be developed.


