#### INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a W. & L.E. Gurley light mountain transit.

The courses were deflected from true meridians as determined from direct sun observations.

The distances were measured with 50 ft. and 660 ft. steel tapes.

#### REPORT

The public land corners to which this survey is tied are stone properly set and marked.

Cor.4 Superior lode Sur.No.2452 is a stone in place properly marked.

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Cor.1 Superior lode Sur.No.2452 falls in creek bed and the witness corner to same is obliterated, so the record course for line 4-1 was used.


All corners of Square Deal and Girtrude lodes Sur.No.2860 are stone properly set and marked; Cor.4 Girtrude lode however has been destroyed.
