Sec.23 T.16 N.R.2 E. tied to herein is a lin.iron pipe, with bronze cap properly lettered. All corners of Sur.No.1284 are now concrete monuments with iron pipe in center, replacing the original stone corners which are lying alongside.

Cors.of Sur.No.1615 are described previously in these notes, excepting Cor.No.3 Needle Point, identical with Cor.No.2 Walnut Creek lode, which is a large porphyry stone, set in base of rock and concrete, in its original position.
