No. 1 situated on the south end line of the Amethyst lode unsurveyed, N. 65°-54'E. 613.0 from the southwest corner and 300 feet from the south end center, a granite stone, 6x8x24 inches long set twelve inches in the ground with a substantial mound of stone alongside; chiseled C N 1-4025 with cross on top for exact corner point, whence,

A granite rock in place 4x6x4 feet exposed and chiseled BxR C N 1 4025 brs. N. 59°-06'E. 125.8 ft.

1465.0 Cross old road brs. east to west.

1500.0 TO COR. NO. 2, a granite stone 8x10x24 inches long set twelve inches in the ground with a substantial mound of stone alongside; chiseled C N 2 4025 with cross on top for exact corner point, whence,

A granite boulder 4x2x2 feet exposed and chiseled BxR C N 2 4025 brs. S. 81°-41'E. 44.2 feet.

250 cross old road brs. north to south.

307.1 SOUTH CENTER END, a mound of stone.

606.0 TO COR. NO. 3, a diorite stone 6x8x24 inches long set twelve inches in the ground with a substantial mound of stone alongside; chiseled C N 3 4025 with cross on top for exact corner point, whence,

A granite rock in place 6x4x3 feet exposed and chiseled BxR C N 3 4025 brs. S.12°-49'W. 33.8 ft.

A high post on top of Denver Hill, being U.S.L. M.No.1477 brs. (approximately) S.22°-50'E.

NO.4, where it was impracticable to set a stone for corner due to water course, <sup>running N.E.</sup> so I established a witness corner S.26°-34'-30"E. 13.2 feet, a granite stone 4x12x24 inches long set twelve inches in the ground with a substantial mound of stone alongside, chiseled W C C N 4 4025 with cross on top for exact corner point, whence, (from witness corner)

A granite reef 3x6x2 feet exposed and chiseled BxR C N 4 4025. brs. N.18°-27'W. 15.1 feet.

Thence N.76°-11'E. (from true cor.)

307.2 NORTH CENTER END, a mound of stone.

614.3 TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING. All corners are identical with their respective locations. Variation at all corners 14°-30'E.

No.2 a cut and tunnel, the mouth of cut brs. N.17-30'E. 397 feet from Cor. No.3, cut 4x18x10 foot face running southeast, tunnel 4x6<sup>ft</sup>x running same course 24 feet to crosscut, thence northeast 10 ft. also southwest 42 feet, having a total length of 76 feet. Value \$875.00

No.3 a shaft, the center of which brs. N.9-45'W. 762 feet <sup>from Cor. No.3</sup> 4x6x60 feet deep (estimated) Value \$600.00

No.4 a cut and tunnel, the mouth of cut brs. N. 1-30'E. 845 feet from Cor. No.3, cut 4x15x10 foot face tunnel 4x6x50 ft (estimated) brs. southeast. Value \$600.00

#### INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Lietz Light Mountain transit, No. 5905. The courses were deflected from the true meridian, as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 500 foot steel tape.

#### REPORT

U.S.L.M.No. 1623 is a post properly set and scribed as shown by the calls in the field notes of said monument.

All corners adjoining this survey are stones properly set and chiseled with the number of the corner and survey.

Amethyst lode, unsurveyed.

The corners of this lode were stone monuments, originally of proper size but now dilapidated.

The discrepancies found existing between the claim as marked by the location monuments and as described in the location notices are due to errors in the location notices.

Owing to the fact that a Notary Public was not available and to avoid delays and expense to obtain an acknowledgment of my assistants in filling out Final Oath for Surveys, I took the acknowledgments of my assistants.

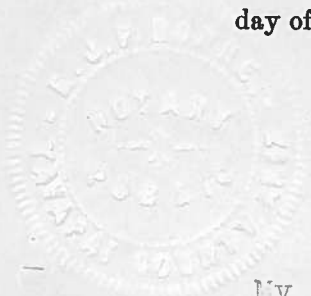


