LOCATION

This survey is located in Sections 26-27-34 Unsurveyed T.10 N.R.1 W, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Tiger Mining District, Prescott National Forest, Yavapai County, State of Arizona.

EXPENDITURE OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS

No.1 Discovery cut, the face of which bears N.44°-18'E. 15.0 ft from the south center end, 4x15x10 foot face caved, bears northeast. Value \$100.00

No.2 A tunnel, entering this claim at a point directly under the south center end, running thence northeasterly 35 feet, tunnel caved and inaccessible, size 4x6 ft. (21 ft of tunnel and 5 ft. of cut extends southwesterly.) Value 35 ft. \$350.00

#### INSTRUMENT

This survey was made with a Lietz Light Mountain transit No.9503. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observations. The distances were measured with a 500 foot steel tape.

#### REPORT

The north 1/4 cor.Sec. 26, T.10 N.R.1 W is a monument of stone three feet high, from which a pine tree 24 inches in diameter and properly scribed brs. westerly 19.4 ft. and a white oak tree 12 inches in diameter properly scribed brs. easterly 28.9 ft.

#### Lot.49

All corners adjoining this survey are stones properly set and chiseled with the number of the corner and survey.

#### Sur.No.1830

All corners adjoining this survey are stones properly set and chiseled with the number of the corner and survey. I do not agree with the course and distance of lines 1-2, 2-3, 3-4, North Oro Bonito lode of this survey.

#### Sur.No. 2863

All corners adjoining this survey are stones properly set and chiseled with the number of the corner and survey.

The discrepancies found existing between the claim as marked by the location monuments and as described in the location notices are due to errors in the location notices.

The discrepancies between the lines of this survey and prior approved surveys are due to errors in the latter.


