Feet	<p>Mineral Survey No. 4252 was made with a Gurley Precise Transit No. 241014, model No. 92, with horizontal limb 5.65 ins. diam., having two double opposite verniers, and full vertical circle 5 ins. diam., having one double vernier; the verniers read to one minute of arc. Extra eye piece equipped with color glass was used for making direct observation upon the sun. The instrument was in good condition at the time of the survey and all adjustments were in good order. An a.m. altitude observation of the sun for azimuth and in the evening an altitude observation on Polaris at lower culmination for latitude and time, were made at a corner of survey No. 4252, the details of which observations are shown in the calculation sheets herewith submitted for examination.</p> <p>The lines were measured with a Lufkin steel tape 500 feet in length, graduated every foot for the entire length, each end foot being graduated in tenths and hundredths; the tape was compared with a Lufkin standard at a time before the beginning of survey No. 4252 and found to be correct.</p> <p>All lines and connections of this survey were run by direct methods.</p> <p>The magnetic variation observed at each corner of the survey gave a uniform value of $14^{\circ} 45'$ E.</p>

Subject: Cancellation of Mineral Surveys

The Golden R.D., Virginia and Kathryn lodes, Mineral Survey No. 4252, were contested (Contest 10020) by complaint issued July 12, 1957. Hearing was held December 6, 1957. Hearing Examiner's decision of January 29, 1958 declared the three claims to be null and void. Contest was closed April 4, 1958 and patent application case was closed April 15, 1958.

The Little Tony lode, Mineral Survey No. 2729, was contested (Contest 10524) by complaint issued September 18, 1962. No answer was filed and closing decision issued December 13, 1962, declared the claim null and void.

It is advisable at this time to cancel the survey of the Golden R.D., Virginia, Kathryn and Little Tony lodes. You are authorized to mark the plats for these claims showing the survey is cancelled by this memorandum. No notations should be made on the field notes.
