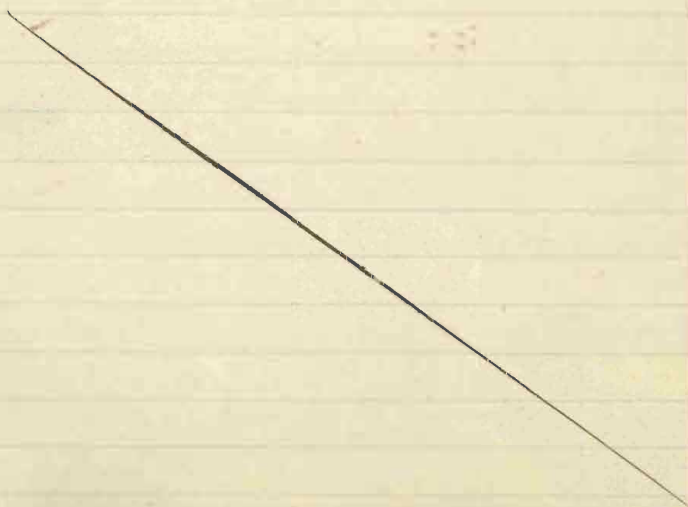

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

Township 17 N. range 20 E. contains a large area of good agricultural land in the northern and Eastern portions. The Little Colorado river flows across its entire width in the northern portion with a large volume of water and easily accessible for irrigation. In section 3 is one of the best dams on the river.

The southwestern portion of the township is broken by a remarkable series of cañons, of great depth and precipitous descents, which suddenly disappear in a different substratum to the N.

There are some scattering Cedar trees in the S, and some cottonwood trees along the river in the N. I found no evidence of mineral in the Township.
