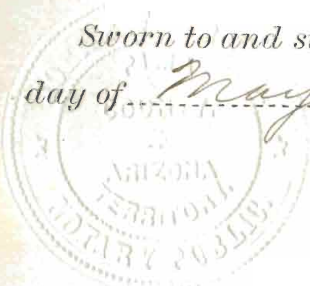

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

The best land in Township 18 N. range 17 E. lies N. and W. of the river, the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Township containing much fine agricultural land.

There is sufficient water in the Little Colorado river for the irrigation of this land. The river flows across the entire township from E. to W.

In the S. E. portion of the township are some cienegas with a great deal of water in them.

The Salt Creek in the southern portion of the township is a beautiful stream of water in considerable volume but the water is brackish and salty. A short distance up this stream it flows out of remarkable Cañon of great depth and magnitude.

I found no mineral in the township. There is but little wood in the township.
